

## RESOLUTION 2026-###

### RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN PABLO AUTHORIZING THE WAIVER OF FEES FOR USE OF DAVIS PARK SPORTS FIELDS AND CONCESSION STAND FOR THE SAN PABLO COWBOYS YOUTH ASSOCIATION (SPCYA) FOR THE 2026 SUMMER AND FALL SEASON

WHEREAS, On June 1, 2026, Andre Williams, President of the San Pablo Cowboys Youth Association (SPCYA), submitted a letter to the City of San Pablo requesting a waiver of rental fees for the use of Davis Park Sports Fields and Davis Park Concession Stand for the following days and times from July 6 – December 20, 2026:

- Monday – Friday 6:30 pm-9:00 pm July 6 – August 14, 2026
- Monday – Friday 4:00 pm – 9:00 pm starting August 17, 2026
- Saturday – Sunday 8:00 am - 5:00 pm
- Exceptions: City Holidays/Closure Dates

WHEREAS, SPCYA offers a diverse youth football and cheerleading program that provides approximately 100 San Pablo youth the ability to travel to numerous cities and compete against various football and cheerleading teams. Participants are recognized for their accomplishments in athletics as well as scholastics to assure them that they are always winners for taking the initiative to do their best;

WHEREAS, the SPCYA partnered with the non-profit agency New Life Movement (NLM) and is currently operating under NLM's 501(c)(3) status;

WHEREAS, City of San Pablo staff has received written verification of this partnership and NLM's 501(c)(3) status is in good standing;

WHEREAS, at the time of submittal the SPCYA was still accepting applications and therefore does not yet have complete participant rosters;

WHEREAS, once registration is closed and final rosters have been received, staff will review and report the residency findings to the City Manager;

WHEREAS, fees for the current season are \$400 with a \$30 discount for San Pablo residents;

WHEREAS, for FY 2026-27, approval of this resolution may result in forgoing an amount not to exceed approximately \$23,000 in potential General Fund 100 rental revenue;

WHEREAS, *Expand safe, family friendly park space*, is an adopted priority item under the FY 2025-27 City Council Priority Workplan, effective April 7, 2025; and

WHEREAS, this proposed action is not a project as defined by CEQA.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the foregoing recitations are true and

correct, and are included herein by reference as findings;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of San Pablo hereby authorizes the waiver of fees for use of Davis Park Sports Fields and Concession Stand for the SPCYA for the 2026 summer fall season;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that as a condition of the fee waiver for use of Davis Park Sports Fields, a representative of the SPCYA must participate in at least two of the following major City events in order to market its program, interact with the public, and/or receive registrations for its program: Spring Eggstravaganza, Fourth of July, City Hall-O-Ween and Holiday Tree Lighting;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that participants in SPCYA programs who reside within the incorporated City of San Pablo boundaries must receive a reduced registration rate for the season; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a majority of the registered participants must be San Pablo residents.
