RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN PABLO (1) APPROVING AND ADOPTING THE PLANS AND SPECIFICATIONS FOR THE GIANT ROAD PAVEMENT REHABILITATION (CIP 0601); (2) ACCEPTING AND APPROPRIATING ONE BAY AREA GRANT 2 (OBAG 2) FUNDS IN THE AMOUNT OF \$618,000 TO THE PROJECT; (3) AWARDED A CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT TO VSS INTERNATIONAL, INC., IN THE AMOUNT OF \$626,211 WITH A 15% CONTINGENCY FOR A TOTAL CONTRACT AUTHORIZATION NOT TO EXCEED AMOUNT \$720,143; AND (4) AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE THE CONSTRUCTION AGREEMENT WITH VSS INTERNATIONAL, LLC

WHEREAS, in October 2019, the Metropolitan Transportation Commission (MTC), through the One Bay Area Grant 2 (OBAG 2) Local Streets and Roads Preservation Program, awarded the City of San Pablo \$618,000 in federal funding for the Giant Road Pavement Rehabilitation Project (0601);

WHEREAS, the Giant Road Pavement Rehabilitation Project (0601) will rehabilitate Giant Road between Brookside Drive and Miner Avenue through pavement base failure repairs, crack sealing, slurry sealing, construction of ADA-compliant curb ramps, and roadway restriping to improve pavement conditions and enhance roadway safety;

WHEREAS, following the grant award, the City completed the design, environmental review, right-of-way certification, and federal authorization requirements necessary to advance the project to construction;

WHEREAS, on May 14, 2026, the City advertised a Notice Inviting Bids for construction of the Giant Road Pavement Rehabilitation Project (0601), and on May 28, 2026, issued Addendum No. 1 revising the bid schedule;

WHEREAS on June 4, 2026, the City publicly opened two bids for construction of the project, and VSS International, Inc. submitted the lowest responsive and responsible bid in the amount of \$626,211 and properly acknowledged Addendum No. 1;

WHEREAS, City staff reviewed the bid submitted by VSS International, Inc. and determined it to be responsive to the bidding requirements and recommends award of the construction contract;

WHEREAS, staff recommends approving a fifteen percent (15%) construction contingency in the amount of \$93,932, for a total contract authorization not to exceed \$720,143;

WHEREAS, staff further recommends accepting \$618,000 in OBAG 2 grant funds to account code 320-0601-33402-OBA-121, and appropriating the funds to account code 320-0601-43604-OBA-121; and

WHEREAS, the remaining local funding in the amount of \$102,143 will be provided through previously appropriated SB1 Road Maintenance and Rehabilitation Account (RMRA) funds, account code 320-0601-43604-SB1-326, authorized by City Council Resolution No. 2025-119 as part of the Fiscal Year 2025/26 Capital Improvement Program Budget, and no additional local appropriation is required.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of San Pablo hereby:

- (1) Approves the plans and specifications for the Giant Road Pavement Rehabilitation Project (0601);
- (2) Accepts One Bay Area Grant 2 (OBAG 2) funds in the amount of \$618,000 to account code 320-0601-33402-OBA-121, and appropriates the funds to account code 320-0601-43604-OBA-121;
- (3) Awards a construction contract to VSS International, Inc. for the Giant Road Pavement Rehabilitation Project (0601) in the amount of \$626,211;
- (4) Approves a fifteen percent (15%) construction contingency in the amount of \$93,932, for a total contract authorization not to exceed \$720,143; and
- (5) Authorizes the City Manager, or designee, to execute the construction agreement with VSS International, Inc., in substantially the form presented to the City Council, subject to approval as to form by the City Attorney, and to execute any documents and approve change orders within the authorized contingency necessary to complete the project.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the foregoing recitations are true and correct and are included herein by reference as findings.
