RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN PABLO APPROVING THE ACCEPTANCE OF PRIVATE DONATIONS AND AUTHORIZING THE INSTALLATION OF A MEMORIAL PLAQUE IN HONOR OF FORMER PUBLIC WORKS DIRECTOR ALLAN PANGANIBAN

WHEREAS, former Public Works Director Allan Panganiban passed away on May 9, 2026, after eight years of dedicated service to the City of San Pablo;

WHEREAS, the City Council previously adopted Resolution 2017-188, establishing the City's Policy for Naming, Dedication, Sponsorship of City Facilities, and Acceptance of Donations;

WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution 2017-188, the City Council must approve the placement of any memorial plaque honoring an individual or deceased person, and the type, size, font, and placement of such plaques are at the sole discretion of the City Council;

WHEREAS, due to a lack of quorum, the Community Services Standing Committee was unable to review or receive the presentation for this item as scheduled on July 23, 2026; and, as a result, the item was forwarded directly to the City Council for consideration and approval;

WHEREAS, staff has proposed the installation of a memorial plaque honoring Allan Panganiban along the Wildcat Creek Trail behind City Hall; and

WHEREAS, the total cost of the memorial plaque is estimated at \$1,625 and will be funded through private donations and donated labor, with no Public Works Department funds or other City funds used for the fabrication or installation of the memorial plaque.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of San Pablo hereby:

1. Accepts private donations for the fabrication and installation of a memorial plaque honoring former Public Works Director Allan Panganiban;
2. Approves the installation of the memorial plaque along the Wildcat Creek Trail behind City Hall;

3. Authorizes the City Manager, or designee, to take all actions necessary to implement this Resolution, including accepting private donations and coordinating the fabrication and installation of the memorial plaque in accordance with Resolution 2017-188; and

BE IT FUTHER RESOLVED that the foregoing recitations are true and correct and are included herein by reference as findings.
