**RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN PABLO (1) ACCEPTING AND APPROPRIATING GRANT FUNDS FROM THE ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AGENCY (EPA) TO THE SAN PABLO STORMWATER TRACKING, OPERATIONS & RUNOFF MAINTENANCE (SP-STORM) PROJECT (0908) IN THE AMOUNT OF \$1,260,600; AND (2) AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE AGREEMENTS NECESSARY TO RECEIVE SUCH GRANT FUNDS**

WHEREAS, in February 2026, the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) was accepting applications for the Water Quality Restoration Grant Program within the San Francisco Bay Program;

WHEREAS, this competitive funding opportunity supports projects that improve water quality and make measurable progress toward restoring San Francisco Bay and its watersheds;

WHEREAS, the goal to *Identify and Implement Long-Term Environmental Stewardship Goals* is an adopted policy item under the FY 2025-27 Council Priority Workplan;

WHEREAS, the City of San Pablo has a need to address Green Stormwater Infrastructure (GSI) monitoring and maintenance as part of the City's National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) permit requirements;

WHEREAS, on February 17, 2026, San Pablo City Council approved a grant application pursuant to Resolution 2026-021;

WHEREAS, the San Pablo Public Works Department submitted an application for monitoring of the Sutter Ave. Green Street Project and operations and maintenance funding for Rumrill Boulevard and Sutter Ave. Green Stormwater Infrastructure (GSI) projects and called the project the *San Pablo Stormwater Tracking, Operations & Runoff Maintenance (SP-STORM) Project*;

WHEREAS, on February 18, 2026, the Public Works Department was notified that the City of San Pablo was awarded a \$1,260,600 grant from the EPA Water Quality Restoration Grant Program within the San Francisco Bay; and

WHEREAS, the fiscal impact is detailed in the table below:

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Manager or his designee is hereby authorized to execute the grant application and to take such other actions as may be reasonably necessary to effectuate the City’s receipt of the EPA Water Quality Restoration Grant Program funding described in this resolution; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the foregoing recitations are true and correct and are included herein by reference as findings.
