Mother's Day Celebration (800+ attendees, May 9, 2026, \$13,000),
Father's Day Celebration (700+ attendees, June 20, 2026, \$7,500),
San Pablo Festival – Fiesta Patrias (1,500 attendees, September 12, 2026, \$16,000),
Halloween Community Event (2,000 attendees, October 31, 2026, \$5,500),
Christmas Toy Giveaway (2,500 toys distributed, December 22, 2026, \$8,000), and
Three Wise Men Toy Giveaway (1,500 toys distributed, January 6, 2027, \$6,000).

These events provide safe, inclusive, and family-friendly environments while distributing essential resources, celebrating cultural heritage, and supporting local businesses.

In addition, we host **educational and legal forums**, including immigration workshops and business-focused consultations with attorneys, helping residents and entrepreneurs navigate complex legal and business challenges.

Funds will be allocated to cover event supplies, toys, marketing, venue costs, staffing, and operational expenses to ensure high-quality delivery.

The program will **launch with the Mother's Day Celebration on May 9, 2026**, and **conclude with the Three Wise Men Toy Giveaway on January 6, 2027**, aligning with key community events to maximize participation, resource distribution, and measurable impact.
