RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN PABLO, CONTRA COSTA COUNTY, CALIFORNIA (1) CONFIRMING THE DIAGRAM AND ASSESSMENTS AS SET FORTH IN THE ENGINEER'S REPORT FOR THE SAN PABLO STREET LIGHTING AND LANDSCAPE ASSESSMENT DISTRICT NO. 1982-1 FOR FISCAL YEAR 2026-27; (2) DIRECTING THE CITY CLERK TO FILE THE DIAGRAM AND ASSESSMENTS WITH THE COUNTY AUDITOR NO LATER THAN AUGUST 10, 2026; AND (3) LEVYING ASSESSMENTS

WHEREAS, in August 1982, the City Council of the City of San Pablo ordered the formation of and levied the first assessment within San Pablo Street Lighting and Landscape District No. 1982-1 (the "District");

WHEREAS, The District received approval from approximately two thirds of the voters voting in the General Election held on November 5, 1996, and the District assessments are therefore exempt from the procedures and approval process set forth in Section 4 of Article XIII D of the State Constitution;

WHEREAS, on April 20, 2026, the City Council adopted Resolution 2026-060, directing the District Engineer to prepare and file a report for the levy of annual assessments within the District for Fiscal Year 2026-27;

WHEREAS, the District Engineer did file a report with the City Clerk;

WHEREAS, on May 18, 2026, the City Council adopted Resolution 2026-067, which preliminarily approved the Engineer's Report, declared intention to levy and collect assessments within the District for Fiscal Year 2026-27 in Fund 237, set a Public Hearing for June 15, 2026, and directed the City Clerk to publish a notice of the Public Hearing pursuant to Streets and Highways Code Section 22626(a) and Government Code Section 6061, which notice has been published;

WHEREAS, on June 15, 2026, the City Council held a Public Hearing to consider levying proposed assessments within the District for Fiscal Year 2026-27, afforded all interested persons an opportunity to hear and be heard, and considered all oral statements and written communications made or filed by interested parties; and

WHEREAS, upon conclusion of the Public Hearing held on June 15, 2026, no majority protest was determined to exist regarding the proposed assessments for the District for Fiscal Year 2026-27.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of San Pablo hereby confirms the diagram and assessments as set forth within the Engineer's Report for the District for Fiscal Year 2026-27;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the assessment rates for the District are not proposed to be increased from Fiscal Year 2025-26;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this Resolution shall constitute the levy of an assessment for Fiscal Year 2026-27 within the District, as referred to in the Engineer's Report;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Council directs the City Clerk to file the diagram and assessments, or a certified copy of them, with the County Auditor no later than August 10, 2026; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of San Pablo hereby finds that the foregoing recitations are true and correct and are included herein by reference as findings.
