RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN PABLO AUTHORIZING AN EVENT SPONSORSHIP IN THE AMOUNT OF \$1,500 TO NUTURING INDEPENDENCE THROUGH ARTISITC DEVELOPMENT ("NIAD") FOR ITS GLAMOUR MOVES EVENT ON SEPTEMBER 12, 2026

WHEREAS, Major Policy Goals: Enhance Community Resilience and Build a Healthy Community are adopted policy items under the FY 2025-27 Council Priority Workplan, effective April 7, 2025;

WHEREAS, this proposed action is not a project as defined by CEQA;

WHEREAS, the City Manager's Office received a request for sponsorship from Nurturing Independence Through Artistic Development (NIAD) to support its Glamour Moves Event;

WHEREAS, the event is scheduled on Saturday, September 12, 2026, from 1PM – 4PM at the NIAD Art Center (551 23rd Street, Richmond) and is open to the general public with a pay what you wish general admission model (\$0 - \$25);

WHEREAS, NIAD is a non-profit, 501(c)(3) organization and has expanded into an in-person and virtual program supporting more than 75 artists to exhibit their work at galleries, museums, and fairs worldwide;

WHEREAS, the Glamour Moves Event is a celebration where community members gather to support NIAD artists as they showcase their designs on a runway;

WHEREAS, NIAD serves artists daily, including artists that are San Pablo residents;

WHEREAS, the San Pablo City Council recently adopted a policy on funding one-time, discretionary grant awards for special events activities and events sponsored by eligible non-profit organizations (Resolution 2026-074).

WHEREAS, as part of the policy, City Council may exercise its own discretion in awarding one-time public financial assistance to eligible organizations or groups contingent upon the following requirements:

- Demonstrated community benefit that enriches the local community;
- Attendance is open to the general public;
- The activity does not pose unreasonable public safety risks or liability impacts on public property or in City facilities;

WHEREAS, the above requirements have been reviewed by City staff as follows:

Requirement	Staff Recommendation
Demonstrated community benefit that enriches the local community	<i>Requirement satisfied.</i> Event location is in adjacent City of Richmond and benefits adult artists with disabilities.
Attendance is open to the general public	<i>Requirement satisfied.</i> Event attendance is open to the general public with a pay what you wish general admission model (\$0 - \$25).
The activity does not pose unreasonable public safety risks or liability impacts on public property or in City facilities	<i>Requirement Satisfied.</i>

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of San Pablo hereby authorizes a sponsorship in the amount of \$1,500 to Nurturing Independence through Artistic Development ("NIAD") for its Glamour Moves Event;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a total of \$30,000 has been appropriated for Special Event Sponsorships under the City Manager's Contingency Operating Reserve (Fund 190) pursuant to Resolution 26-074. The authorized sponsorship in the amount of \$1,500 will be deducted from this account code leaving a remaining balance of \$14,500 in FY 2026-27 for future sponsorships approved by the City Council; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the foregoing recitations are true and correct and are included herein by reference as findings.
