RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN PABLO APPROVING THE REMAINING FY 2026-27 FINAL SAN PABLO COMMUNITY FOUNDATION GRANT PROGRAM AWARDS TOTALING \$113,000, AND ACCEPTING THE APPROPRIATION OF \$45,000 IN EXTERNAL FUNDING FROM THREE SOURCES AND FY 2025-26 GFDR FUND 110 FUND BALANCE TO THE FY 2026-27 CITY COUNCIL SPECIAL EVENTS BUDGET (100-1110-44050) TO FULLY FUND THE PROGRAM

WHEREAS, the San Pablo Community Foundation Grant Program 501(c)(3) – falls under the blanket category of *Build A Healthy Community – Improve Connection to Healthy Eating and Active Living With All Applicable City Programs and Services*, an adopted policy item under the FY 2025-27 Council Priority Workplan, effective April 7, 2025;

WHEREAS, the City Council appropriated \$75,000 from the FY 2025-26 GFDR Fund 110 Fund Balance to the City Council Departmental Budget (100-1110-44050) to provide financial assistance to non-profit 501(c)(3) organizations, and establish a FY 2026-27 Annual San Pablo Community Foundation Grant Program, and following the separate action taken by the City Council tonight, \$68,000 of those funds remain available for award;

WHEREAS, an additional \$45,000 in grant funding has also been received to support the program from three outside sources as follows: the Lytton Rancheria Band of Pomo Indians - \$25,000; Republic Services, Inc., dba Richmond Sanitary Services - \$15,000; and the San Pablo Senior Advisory Board - \$5,000 in Fund 100-0000-33403 to Fund 100-1110-44050;

WHEREAS, with combined funding from all sources, there is \$113,000 in total program funding remaining available for the Annual San Pablo Community Foundation Grant Program for FY 2026-27;

WHEREAS, the City Manager and staff finalized all SPCF grant application guidelines and officially announced the availability of the FY 2026-27 SPCF Grant Program application guidelines to the public on February 3, 2026, with a grant submittal deadline of April 3, 2026;

WHEREAS, the City of San Pablo received twenty-five (25) eligible applications for FY 2026-27 funding consideration, which totaled \$233,143 in funding requests for the FY 2026-27 grant program year;

WHEREAS, the San Pablo Community Foundation Grant Review Committee reviewed all eligible applications for several weeks leading up to the presentation meeting;

WHEREAS, on May 11, 2026, the San Pablo Community Foundation Grant Review Committee received final presentations from the eligible grantees and deliberated before making their final recommendations to the City Council for the FY 2026-27 SPCF Annual Grant Program; and

WHEREAS, the San Pablo Community Foundation Grant Review Committee recommends that the City Council award the remaining sixteen (16) applicants grant funding for FY 2026-27.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of San Pablo hereby authorizes the following grants and directs the City Manager to prepare disbursements to be sent to the following organizations by the first week of July, 2026:
