

## RESOLUTION 2026-###

### RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN PABLO ENDORSING THE CONTRA COSTA COMMUNITY COLLEGE DISTRICT FACILITIES BOND MEASURE (MEASURE G) ON THE JUNE 2, 2026 STATEWIDE PRIMARY BALLOT

WHEREAS, *Under Major Policy Area: Build A Healthy Community, Policy #102 102. Foster College and Career Readiness, Education, Youth Leadership, and City/Contra Costa College/WCCUSD Partnerships under the FY 2025-27 City of San Pablo Council Priority Workplan, effective April 7, 2025;*

WHEREAS, the Contra Costa Community College District (“4CD”) serves more than 50,000 students across Contra Costa County through its colleges—Contra Costa College, Diablo Valley College, and Los Medanos College - and their satellite campuses;

WHEREAS, 4CD has placed Measure G, a general obligation bond measure, on the ballot to fund critical repairs, upgrades, and improvements to aging college facilities throughout the District;

WHEREAS, many residents of San Pablo enroll in 4CD colleges, making the quality and accessibility of those institutions directly relevant to the educational pathways available to our community;

WHEREAS, Measure G funds would be used to repair deteriorating roofs, plumbing, and electrical systems; upgrade classrooms and labs to meet current academic and workforce training standards; improve campus safety and security infrastructure; and increase energy efficiency to reduce long-term operating costs;

WHEREAS, community colleges play a vital role in providing affordable higher education, career technical education, transfer pathways to four-year universities, and workforce development programs that benefit local employers and the regional economy;

WHEREAS, an independent citizens’ oversight committee and mandatory annual audits would ensure that all bond funds are spent as promised and that no funds are used for administrator salaries or benefits;

WHEREAS, well-maintained and modern community college facilities support student success, strengthen the local workforce pipeline, and contribute to the economic vitality of our community; and

WHEREAS, the San Pablo City Council recognizes the importance of investing in educational infrastructure at all levels to ensure that students have access to safe, modern, and well-equipped learning environments.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of San Pablo hereby endorses Measure G, the Contra Costa Community College District Facilities Bond, and urges the voters of Contra Costa County to vote "Yes on G";

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of San Pablo authorizes the City Manager, or designee, to communicate this endorsement to the Contra Costa Community College District, to the public, and to any other interested parties;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Council directs the City Manager, or designee, to transmit a certified copy of this Resolution to the Chancellor of the Contra Costa Community College District; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the foregoing recitations are true and correct and are included herein by reference as findings.
