RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN PABLO ACCEPTING MEASURE J PROGRAM 28B FUNDS FROM THE COSTA TRANSPORTATION AUTHORITY IN THE AMOUNT OF \$60,000 AND APPROPRIATING THOSE FUNDS TO THE WILDCAT CREEK CROSSING IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT (0702)

WHEREAS, in 2021, the City of San Pablo completed the Wildcat Creek and Greenway Trail Restoration Project, which established a Class I multi-use trail between Chattleton/Church Lane and Vale Road;

WHEREAS, the City subsequently identified the need to enhance street crossings at trail entry points to improve safety for pedestrians and cyclists, resulting in the Wildcat Creek Trail Crossing Improvements Project (0702);

WHEREAS, the City previously secured and appropriated Transportation Development Act (TDA) Article 3 grant funds and Measure J Local Street Maintenance (LSM) funds to support the project;

WHEREAS, in June 2025, Measure J Program 28b funds were allocated to member agencies by the West Contra Costa Transportation Commission (WCCTC);

WHEREAS, on September 17, 2025, the City entered into a cooperative agreement with the Contra Costa Transportation Authority (CCTA) to receive a \$60,000 disbursement of Measure J Program 28b funds;

WHEREAS, the City is required to expend these funds by July 1, 2027, and Public Works staff recommends allocating the Measure J Program 28b funds to the Wildcat Creek Trail Crossing Improvements Project (0702), which is eligible for such funding, to support construction, anticipated to be completed by June 30, 2026; and

WHEREAS, acceptance and appropriation of these funds will not impact the City's General Fund.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of San Pablo hereby:

1. Accepts \$60,000 in Measure J Program 28b funds from the Contra Costa Transportation Authority; and
2. Appropriates \$60,000 in Measure J Program 28b funds to the Wildcat Creek Trail Crossing Improvements Project (0702).

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of San Pablo hereby authorizes the City Manager to take such other actions as may be reasonably necessary to effectuate the intent of this resolution; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the foregoing recitations are true and correct and are included herein by reference as findings.
