WHEREAS, Libby has helped many developers and residents get their projects through the finish line;

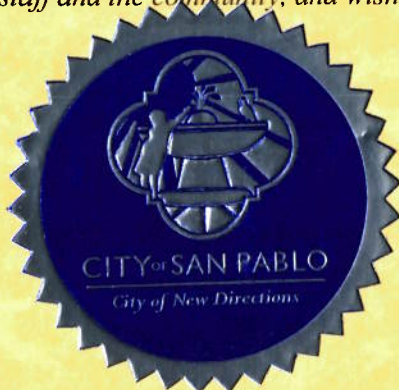
