MARK WONG

**RECIPIENT OF THE 2025 FACULTY MEMBER AWARD
(PACIFIC REGION) BY THE ASSOCIATION OF COMMUNITY
COLLEGE TRUSTEES**

WHEREAS, Mark Wong holds a Bachelor of Science in Physics from UC Berkeley and a Master's in Materials Science and Engineering from UC San Diego; and

WHEREAS, he began teaching Physics and Engineering at Contra Costa College (CCC) as an adjunct professor in August 2007; and

WHEREAS, CCC's student honor society awarded him the Golden Bell distinguished teaching award in 2012; and

WHEREAS, Professor Wong was hired as a full-time tenure-track professor of physics and engineering at CCC in August 2013, then granted tenure at CCC in March 2017; and

WHEREAS, Professor Wong was a finalist for the Contra Costa County Teacher of the Year Award in 2025; and

WHEREAS, Professor Wong plays a pivotal role in mentoring students through CCC's APECS Club, a student-led initiative focused on engineering, flight, and robotics, and along with fellow faculty members, he also helps lead CCC's involvement in NASA's National Community College Aerospace Scholars program, guiding students toward hands-on research and industry-level exploration; and

WHEREAS, on October 23, 2025, in New Orleans, LA, Professor Mark Wong was honored with the 2025 Faculty Member Award for the states of California, Oregon, Washington, Alaska, and Hawaii (known as the Pacific Region) by the Association of Community College Trustees, and was one of five finalists for the national honor.
