Subject: Price Factor and Population Information

Appropriations Limit

California Revenue and Taxation Code Section 2227 requires the Department of Finance to transmit an estimate of the percentage change in population to local governments. Each local jurisdiction must use their percentage change in population factor for January 1, 2025, in conjunction with a change in the cost of living, or price factor, to calculate their appropriations limit for fiscal year 2025-26. Attachment A provides the change in California's per capita personal income and an example for utilizing the price factor and population percentage change factor to calculate the 2025-26 appropriations limit. Attachment B provides the city and unincorporated county population percentage change along with the population percentage change for counties and their summed incorporated areas. The population percentage change data excludes federal and state institutionalized populations and military populations.

Population Percent Change for Special Districts

Some special districts must establish an annual appropriations limit. California Revenue and Taxation Code Section 2228 provides additional information regarding the appropriations limit. Article XIII B, Section 9(C) of the California Constitution exempts certain special districts from the appropriations limit calculation mandate. Special districts required by law to calculate their appropriations limit must present the calculation as part of their annual audit. Any questions special districts have on this requirement should be directed to their county, district legal counsel, or the law itself. No state agency reviews the local appropriations limits.

Population Certification

The population certification program applies only to cities and counties. California Revenue and Taxation Code Section 11005.6 mandates Finance to automatically certify any population estimate that exceeds the current certified population with the State Controller's Office. **Finance will certify the higher estimate to the State Controller by June 1, 2025.**

Please Note: The prior year's city population estimates may be revised. The per capita personal income change is based on historical data.

Attachment

- A. **Price Factor:** Article XIII B specifies that local jurisdictions select their cost of living factor to compute their appropriation limit by a vote of their governing body. The cost of living factor provided here is per capita personal income. If the percentage change in per capita personal income is selected, the percentage change to be used in setting the fiscal year 2025-26 appropriation limit is:

Per Capita Personal Income	
Fiscal Year (FY)	Percentage change over prior year
2025-26	6.44

- B. Following is an example using sample population change and the change in California per capita personal income as growth factors in computing a 2025-26 appropriation limit.

2025-26:

Per Capita Cost of Living Change = 6.44 percent
Population Change = 0.28 percent

Per Capita Cost of Living converted to a ratio: $\frac{6.44 + 100}{100} = 1.0644$

Population converted to a ratio: $\frac{0.28 + 100}{100} = 1.0028$

Calculation of factor for FY 2025-26: $1.0644 \times 1.0028 = 1.0674$

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SACRAMENTO--- California's population grew by 108,000 persons in calendar year 2024 to reach 39,529,000 people as of January 1st, 2025, according to new data reported today by the California Department of Finance.

The 0.28-percent increase marks the second consecutive year of population growth since the COVID-19 Pandemic and reflects the combination of several principal factors:

- Higher 2024 K-8 enrollment of 13,890 compared to 2023.
- An increase in the 65-and-older population of 25,298 people in 2024, up from 6,622,031 people reported last year.
- Natural increase—the net result of births minus deaths—contributed 114,805 to overall population growth in 2024, largely in line with the growth of 105,550 in 2023.
- More data sources to better estimate California's share of recent increases in legal immigration to the U.S. from 2021 to 2024, showing 277,468 more immigrants to the state during this period than in the 2023 estimate.
- The report also reflects an upward revision of California's 2023 population to a growth rate of 0.49 percent, up from its previously estimated 0.2-percent growth rate.

The report contains preliminary year-over-year January 2025 and revised January 2021 through January 2024 population data for California cities, counties, and the state. These estimates are based on information as of January 1, 2025, and therefore do not include data for the Los Angeles County wildfires later that month.

Other highlights of the January 1, 2025 city and county population report include:

- California's 58 counties range in size from Alpine County, with just over 1,170 residents, to Los Angeles County with 9.9 million residents. The population increased in 35 counties, with most growth in the Central Valley, the Inland Empire, and coastal counties. Population gains reflect natural increase exceeding losses in net total migration.
- The state's ten largest counties remain Los Angeles, San Diego, Orange, Riverside, San Bernardino, Santa Clara, Alameda, Sacramento, Contra Costa, and Fresno, with each having more than one million residents. These ten counties represent 72 percent of California's population. Nine of the ten counties with one million or more people have positive population growth, leaving Contra Costa as the only county with a very small population loss of 24 people. Los Angeles led with an increase of 28,000 persons.
- Population growth rates ranged from a high of 2.88 percent in Lassen County to a low of -1.58 percent in Mono County. The next five largest in percentage growth were Glenn (1.35 percent), Fresno (0.87 percent), Sutter (0.83 percent), Imperial (0.81 percent), and Tulare (0.73 percent).

- Statewide housing grew at 0.84 percent in 2024, virtually unchanged from 0.85 in 2023. California added 125,228 housing units on net, including 26,648 Accessory Dwelling Units (ADUs), to bring total housing stock to 14,949,001 units. New construction added 118,957 housing units with 70,694 single family housing units, 53,543 multi-family housing units, and 991 mobile homes. ADUs are included in the single-family category and comprised 37.7 percent of the state's new single-family housing and 21.3 percent of total new housing.

County and city housing highlights include:

- Madera had the highest housing growth (2.65 percent) of all counties, followed by: Placer, San Benito, Yuba, San Joaquin, Butte, Riverside, Kings, Napa, and Yolo.
- The state average housing growth for all counties was 0.8 percent. Fourteen counties gained housing at or above 1.0 percent. One county, Tehama, had a net decline in housing in 2024.
- Within counties ranked by net housing gains, Los Angeles (18,665), San Diego (9,508), Unincorporated Riverside County (3,724), Sacramento (1,909), and Bakersfield (1,765) added the most housing units in 2024.
- Larger densely populated urban areas built most of the multi-family housing throughout the state. Los Angeles led the state gaining 10,217 multi-family units, comprising 54.8 percent of their net housing growth, followed by San Diego (7,025 for 73.9 percent), Sacramento (1,692 for 88.6 percent), and Oakland (1,642 for 96.3 percent).
- Conversely, single family housing is more likely to be built further inland in typically more suburban cities. Cities with a high proportion of single-family growth include Bakersfield (1,428 for 81.0 percent of their net housing growth), Elk Grove (1,053 for 96.7 percent), Fresno (1,028 for 70.2 percent), and Folsom (1,012 for 68.9 percent).
- The top five cities where housing production drove population growth include: Huron (7.9 percent housing growth and 8.0 percent population growth) in Fresno County, Paradise (10.3 percent and 7.8 percent) in Butte County, Shafter (4.9 percent and 4.7 percent) in Kern County, Winters (5.2 percent and 4.1 percent) in Yolo County, and Lathrop (5.6 percent and 4.0 percent) in San Joaquin County.

Also of note in the report:

- 241 cities gained population, while 240 lost population and one (Morro Bay in San Luis Obispo County) had no change.
- Mountain House, in San Joaquin County, is California's newest city, incorporating in July 2024. As of January 2025, Mountain House had an official population of 28,795 and became California's 483rd city.
- Of the ten largest cities in California, seven gained population: Led by Bakersfield (1.16 percent, or 4,787) and San Diego (1.05 percent, or 14,620).
- Accessory Dwelling Unit production increased by 14.3 percent, with the state adding 26,648 ADUs in 2024. In 2023, the state added 22,802 ADUs, a 10-percent increase over the previous year.
- Group quarters represent 2.4 percent (930,233) of the total state population. This population includes those living in college dormitories (280,000) and in correctional facilities (163,000). In 2024, California's group quarters population increased by 2,700 (0.3 percent). The college dormitory population grew by 6,300 (2.3 percent). Correctional facilities declined in population in 2024 by 1,800 people (-1.1 percent) across federal, state and local facilities. Due to significant increases in the college dormitory population, several jurisdictions saw gains in population. The City of Seaside in Monterey County grew by 5.7 percent partially due to a 3.3 percent increase at California State University, Monterey Bay.

The City of Merced in Merced County grew by 5.3 percent due to the annexation of the University of California Merced into the city (4,000 students).

State prisons are generally located in remote areas. As a result, increases or decreases in prison size can account for significant changes in their respective area populations. For example, prison declines contributed to population decreases in Blythe (-11.7 percent) in Riverside County, Avenal (-5.3 percent) in Kings County, and Calipatria (-5.1 percent) in Imperial County. Other cities saw increases in their populations due to changes in this population. For example, Crescent City (8.4 percent) in Del Norte County, Susanville (6.7 percent) in Lassen County, and Folsom (4.0 percent) in Sacramento County.

Background Information

These population estimates are produced annually by the California Department of Finance (Finance) for use by local areas to calculate their annual appropriations limit. The State Controller's Office uses Finance's estimates to update their population figures for distribution of state subventions to cities and counties, and to comply with various state codes. Additionally, estimates are used for research and planning purposes by federal, state, and local agencies, the academic community, and the private sector.

Changes to the housing stock are used in the preparation of the annual city population estimates. Estimated occupancy of housing units and the number of persons per household further determine population levels. Changes in city housing stock result from new construction, demolitions, housing unit conversions, and annexations. The sub-county population estimates are then adjusted to be consistent with independently produced county estimates.

Starting with this estimate, Finance has identified and incorporated additional immigration data sources, including backlog and immigration court outcomes from the Department of Justice and the Transactional Records Access Clearinghouse.

Comparing Census Bureau's recently released July 1, 2024 estimates with Finance's January 1, 2025 estimates should generally be avoided since they refer to different points in time. In addition, there are numerous differences between the two series including different assumptions regarding the effects of natural disasters, changes in migration patterns, and accelerating slowdown in births.

All Finance population and housing estimates are benchmarked to a decennial census. The estimates in this report are benchmarked to the 2020 decennial census.
