As The Latina Center celebrates 25 years of unwavering service, empowerment, and transformation, we invite you to be part of our most meaningful milestone yet building a permanent home for our community.

Inspired by our anniversary theme, "We grew wings: 25 years transforming lives with passion and purpose," this moment marks not only a celebration of how far we've come, but a bold step toward our future. A permanent space will ensure long-term stability and expand our capacity to serve thousands of Latina women, men, seniors, children, youth, and families with dignity, compassion, and culturally rooted care.

Together, we can continue to uplift lives, strengthen leadership, and build lasting change for generations to come.

Over the past 25 years, the programs at The Latina Center have grown to meet the evolving needs of our community. In recent years, we've expanded beyond Richmond into East Contra Costa and Sacramento counties, deepening our regional impact.

Our signature leadership program—Mujer, Salud y Liderazgo (MSL) / Women, Health and Leadership—has been a powerful catalyst for healing, empowerment, and community change. Today, 60 inspiring women are completing their leadership journey, reaching hundreds more through community workshops on mental health, diabetes, domestic violence prevention, and more.

Guided by our core belief, "Each One, Teach One," these leaders are part of a vibrant movement:

- Nearly **1,000 women** have graduated from MSL as peer leaders
- Over **400 youth** have completed our **Young Latinas**, **Future Leaders** program, now integrating robotics, leadership, and STEAM education

- Seniors find connection through knitting, wellness, and conversation circles that reduce isolation
- Each year, 500 families join our parenting education program
- 200 micro-entrepreneurs receive business development support
- Our advocacy and direct services on Health 4 All, immigration, and survivor support reaches over 400 Latinos annually
- We provide trauma-informed support to more than 300 victims of domestic violence and sexual assault each year, offering safety, guidance, and a path to healing

The ripple effect of our leadership work has even led to the founding of three nonprofit organizations by MSL graduates—a living testament to our community's ability to lead for lasting change.

Our story is best told through women like Narcisa, who arrived in pain after enduring years of violence. Her daughter had been taken by Child Protective Services. With the support of our staff and community, Narcisa found her voice, healed, and emerged as a leader. As part of her MSL project, she created an advocacy initiative to help others navigate the court system. Today, she is a small business owner in our Microenterprise Program—and, most importantly, reunited with her daughter.

Despite our deep impact, The Latina Center still faces a significant challenge: we do not yet have a permanent home. A stable, community-owned space will allow us to expand our services, strengthen our programs, and ensure that this vital work continues for generations to come.


