RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN PABLO AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE A THREE-YEAR AGREEMENT WITH SENSEON TECH LTD. FOR ENDPOINT DETECTION AND RESPONSE SERVICES IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$57,000

WHEREAS, *Strengthen Existing and New Technology Programs, Public Facility/Infrastructure Projects, and Future Workplace Development Programs/Services to Enhance SPPD Crime-Reduction Goals, Community Policing, Mental Health, and Training Programs* is an adopted policy item under the FY 2025-27 City Council Priority Workplan, adopted April 7, 2025;

WHEREAS, the Information Technology (IT) Division has utilized the SenseOn Tech Ltd. ("SenseOn") platform since FY24 to provide modern endpoint protection, 24/7 Security Operations Center (SOC) monitoring, and rapid threat response;

WHEREAS, City staff have determined the SenseOn solution has performed effectively and wish to continue utilizing the platform under a new multi-year agreement to ensure cost savings and pricing stability;

WHEREAS, pursuant to San Pablo Municipal Code Section 3.16.110(B), the City may forgo competitive bidding when procuring intellectual property bundled with specialized services that are integral to the use of the product;

WHEREAS, the City conducted an informal bidding process and received proposals from three vendors—SenseOn (\$57,000 over three years), CIS CrowdStrike (\$59,400 over three years), and Xerox SentinelOne (\$107,531 over three years)—and determined that SenseOn offers the best overall value to the City; and

WHEREAS, the total contract cost of \$57,000 will be appropriated from the IT Division's operating budget (Account No. 100-1510-42005).

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of San Pablo hereby authorizes the City Manager to execute a three-year agreement with SenseOn in an amount not to exceed \$57,000 for endpoint detection and response services; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the foregoing recitations are true and correct, and are included herein by reference as findings.
