Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant (JAG)

- JAG Grant Program Overview:
 - Federal grant funding to support law enforcement programs
 - Prior grant awards utilized for training and technology enhancement
- Grant Application
 - Initial approved proposal: Acquisition of a BRINC Unmanned Aircraft System (UAS), to support existing public safety operations
 - Revised approved proposal: Acquisition of 62 single-unit portable radio chargers and 25 spare radio batteries
- 2025 Grant Award: \$13,318
 - Public Safety Standing Committee 02/05/25
 - Recommendation to forward to the City Council for formal approval



Motorola Radio Equipment



- Assigned single-unit chargers
 - Increased efficiency of radio communication capabilities for SPPD personnel
- Spare radio batteries
 - Increased operational readiness during incident response and management of critical incidents
- Quoted cost for sixty-two (62) chargers and twenty-five (25) batteries: **\$13,628**
- Cost difference exceeding grant award amount of \$13,318 will be funded by the Police Department's FY25-26 operating budget (Uniform and Safety Equipment account)



Following the public hearing, staff requests Council's consideration for the following:

- *Acceptance and appropriation of awarded funds*, in the amount of \$13,318 to be received from Justice Assistance Grant (JAG) Program, and;
- *Authorization* to utilize awarded grant funds for the acquisition of sixty-two (62) Motorola portable radio chargers and twenty-five (25) spare batteries, to support public safety operations.
