

ORDINANCE 2026-###

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN PABLO AMENDING CHAPTER 15.04 OF THE SAN PABLO MUNICIPAL CODE BY DELETING SECTION 15.04.020.D. IN ITS ENTIRETY

The City Council of the City of San Pablo does ordain as follows:

SECTION 1. SAN PABLO MUNICIPAL CODE AMENDMENT.

Chapter 15.04, Uniform Construction Codes, Section 15.04.020.D, Amendments, additions and deletions to Title 24 Part 6, the 2025 California Energy Code is hereby deleted in its entirety.

SECTION 2. ENVIRONMENTAL REVIEW.

This proposed action is not a project as defined by the California Environmental Quality Act (“CEQA”), pursuant to CEQA Guidelines Section 15378(B)(5): organizational or administrative activities of governments that will not result in direct or indirect physical changes to the environment, and is also exempt from environmental review pursuant to CEQA Guidelines Section 15061(b)(3) (i.e., the “common sense” exemption) in that it can be seen with certainty that there is no possibility that the ordinance will have a significant effect on the environment because it involves removal of regulatory provisions that are not currently being enforced by the City of San Pablo and does not authorize or result in any physical changes to the environment.

SECTION 3. EFFECTIVE DATE; PUBLICATION.

This Ordinance shall become effective thirty (30) days following its adoption. The City Clerk’s Office shall publish and post the Ordinance in accordance with California Government Code Section 36933.
