

RESOLUTION 2017-118

RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN PABLO (1) AWARDING THE AMADOR STREET AND EL PORTAL DRIVE RADAR SPEED SIGNS PROJECT (RAD-SGN) TO THE LOWEST BIDDER, DC ELECTRIC, INC.; (2) AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$61,720 WITH DC ELECTRIC, INC. WITH APPROXIMATELY 10% CONTINGENCY, FOR A TOTAL AUTHORIZATION OF \$68,000; (3) ACCEPTING AND APPROPRIATING \$48,000 FROM TDA GRANT FUNDS; AND (4) REALLOCATING \$20,000 FROM THE GIANT ROAD RAILROAD QUIET ZONE ANALYSIS STUDY (320-3200-43600-GAV-RRZ) TO THE AMADOR STREET AND EL PORTAL DRIVE PROJECT (320-3200-43600-RAD-SGN)

WHEREAS, the project is located along El Portal Drive between Road 20 and Mission Bell Drive, and Amador Street between Alpine Road and Shasta Avenue and consists of installation of two solar powered radar feedback speed signs on Amador Street and four on El Portal Drive;

WHEREAS, the City of San Pablo will file a Notice of Exemption with the Contra Costa County Clerk;

WHEREAS, the City has solicited public bids for the construction of the project in conformance with the formal bidding requirements of State Law and City ordinances, and opened the bids on May 5, 2017; four bid proposals were received;

WHEREAS, the lowest bidder is DC Electric of Cotati, California with a bid in the amount of \$61,720; and

WHEREAS, funding in the amount of \$48,000 will need to be accepted and appropriated from TDA Grant funding and the balance of \$20,000 is available to be reallocated from the FY 2016-17 Capital Improvement Program Giant Road Railroad Quiet Zone Analysis (320-3200-43600-GAV-RRZ) to the Amador Street and El Portal Drive Radar Speed Signs project (320-3200-43600-RAD-SGN).

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of San Pablo hereby awards the bid for the Amador Street and El Portal Drive Radar Speed Signs Project, and authorizes the City Manager to execute an agreement in the amount of \$61,720 with DC Electric, with an approximate contingency of 10% for a total authorized cost of \$68,000.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Council accepts TDA grant funds of \$48,000 into (320-3200-33403-RAD-SGN) and appropriates them to this project (320-3200-43600-RAD-SGN).

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that City Council reallocates \$20,000 from the FY 2016/17 Capital Improvement Program Giant Road Railroad Quiet Zone Analysis (320-3200-43600-GAV-RRZ) to the Amador Street and El Portal Drive Radar Speed Signs project (320-3200-43600-RAD-SGN).
