
WHEREAS, the movement for women's suffrage started right before the Civil War in the United States;

WHEREAS, although a variety of movements had sprung up across the United States it was not until August 26, 1920 that the 19<sup>th</sup> Amendment was enacted which prohibits the states and the federal government from denying the right to vote citizens of the United States on the basis of sex;

WHEREAS, the first celebration was held in 1973 when it was proclaimed Women's Equality Day;

WHEREAS, the 21<sup>st</sup> Theater Sustainment Command (21<sup>st</sup> TSC) is hosting an event in celebration of Women's Equality Day for the Kaiserslautern Military Community in Kaiserslautern, Germany, on August 30, 2018, with Maj.
