RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN PABLO AUTHORIZING FUNDING APPROPRIATIONS TO THE RUMRILL BOULEVARD COMPLETE STREETS PROJECT FROM THE FY 2018/19 GENERAL FUND DESIGNATED RESERVES TO MEET GRANT MATCH FUNDING REQUIREMENTS FOR A TOTAL OF \$1,120,000

WHEREAS, the Rumrill Boulevard. Complete Streets Project is a major City project that proposes to modify Rumrill Boulevard to add Class IV bikeways or cycle tracks in both directions of travel, while reducing the number of vehicle travel lanes in both directions;

WHEREAS, the Project also includes landscaped buffers; parking protection; and striped buffers; potential physical barriers such as landscaping and curbing; traffic signal modifications; improved crosswalks; lighting and concrete improvements; flashing beacons and storm drainage improvements;

WHEREAS, the total cost for the improvements on Rumrill Boulevard is estimated at \$19 million dollars;

WHEREAS, the City of San Pablo has been awarded a total of \$16,254,583 in federal, state and local grant funds, each having restrictions and grant match requirements;

WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution 2017-107 a grant match in the amount of \$143,000 was previously appropriated to the Project;

WHEREAS, the City still needs to meet additional grant match requirements; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution 2019-017, a total of \$1,120,000 from FY 2018/19 General Fund Designated Reserves was allocated for the remaining grant match requirements for this Project.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the foregoing recitations are true and correct, and are included herein by reference as findings.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Council authorizes the City Manager to appropriate the required allocated grant matches to the Rumrill Blvd. Complete Streets Project (320-3200-43600-RUM-CST) pursuant to Resolution 2019-017 to the Rumrill Boulevard Complete Streets Project as follows:

1. Appropriate \$600,000 from the FY 2018/19 General Fund Designated Reserves for PW Streetlight Photovoltaic Master Plan Project (100-0000-49999);

2. Appropriate \$300,000 from the FY 2018/19 General Fund Designated Reserves for Drainage & NPDES MRP Compliance Facilities Improvements (100-0000-49999);
3. Appropriate \$100,000 from the FY 2018/19 General Fund Designated Reserves for PW Grant Match Funds (100-0000-49999); and
4. Appropriate \$120,000 from the FY 2018/19 General Fund Designated Reserves for PW Grant Match Funds (100-0000-49999).
