RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN PABLO AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO SELL POLICE DEPARTMENT VEHICLE 810 (2000 DODGE RAM MAXI VAN) AND VEHICLE 876 (2014 FORD TAURUS) AS SURPLUS PROPERTY AT PUBLIC AUCTION PURSUANT TO SAN PABLO MUNICIPAL CODE SECTION 3.16.120, WITH REVENUE FUNDS RECEIVED TO BE CREDITED TO THE FISCAL YEAR 2023-24 VEHICLE REPLACEMENT FUND ACCOUNT (102-2110-46300)

WHEREAS, Improve Public Safety is one of the top City Council priorities and is an adopted policy item under the FY 2023-25 City of San Pablo City Council Priority Workplan, effective May 1, 2023;

WHEREAS, the Police Department has a 2000 Dodge Ram Maxi Van (Vehicle 810) and a 2014 Ford Taurus (Vehicle 876) that are inoperative due to extensive engine issues;

WHEREAS, Vehicle 810 is currently assigned to the Police Department's Crime Scene Investigations Unit, and the cost of repairs far exceeds the vehicle's current market value of \$1,461;

WHEREAS, Vehicle 876 is assigned to the Patrol Division and has been inoperable since January 2023. This vehicle requires a new engine with an estimated cost of \$7,000 to \$10,000. Due to supply chain shortages, Ford Motor Company estimates a twelve-month delivery timeline for a new engine. The cost of replacing the engine exceeds the vehicle's current market value of \$5,294;

WHEREAS, the Police Department proposes designating Vehicles 810 and 876 in its existing fleet as surplus and disposing of the vehicles by auction pursuant to San Pablo Municipal Code Section 3.16.120, which states:

"All using departments shall submit to the purchasing officer, at such times and in such form as he shall prescribe, reports showing all supplies and equipment which are no longer used or which have become obsolete or worn out. The purchasing officer shall have authority to exchange or trade in all such supplies, equipment and materials; to sell by public auction, sealed bid, or agreement with other public agencies; or sell by direct negotiated agreement, or on a consignment basis. In the event the purchasing officer determines that any such obsolete or surplus property has no salvage value, he may dispose of it as he deems advisable;"

WHEREAS, any revenue funds received from the sale of Vehicles 810 and 876 will be credited to the FY 23/24 Vehicle Replacement Fund Account (102-2110-46300).

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the foregoing recitations are true and correct, and are included herein by reference as findings.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City of San Pablo City Council hereby:

1. Authorizes the City Manager sell Vehicles 810 and 876 as surplus property at public auction; and
2. Revenue funds received from the sale of Vehicles 810 and 876 will be credited to the FY 23/24 Vehicle Replacement Fund Account (102-2110-46300).
