GOALS of the JEWL program will continue to be safety, education, “Restorative Justice” and mentorship. JEWL will effectively extend these tools and techniques throughout the city with the skills already possessed by trained SRO’s, to positively impact our Youth. There will be a collaborative effort to reduce juvenile crime and improve the lives of our youth by providing positive outlets for expression, learning and character development.



The JEWL Officers will :

- ❑ Respond to all school related incidents: truancy, fights, thefts, abuse, assault, mediations, lost property, welfare
- ❑ Be available for any juvenile related call for service in San Pablo, outside of school sites, requiring liaison resources
- ❑ Work in tandem with local youth sporting leagues as well as the San Pablo Recreation Division to participate in computer labs, reading labs or any other resources that promotes health and welfare for the youth in our community.
- ❑ Continue the tradition of teaching GREAT at the San Pablo Community Center during an after school program.
