April 5, 2004, the City Council approved the addendum to the Mitigated Negative Declaration, acknowledged that the applicant had complied with the requirements of the Mitigation and Monitoring Report and found that there was no substantial evidence that the Project, as mitigated, would have a significant effect on the environment. The Project was completed and a certificate of The proposed rehabilitation of the occupancy was issued in August 2006. Project does not involve substantial changes or new information that would require the preparation of a subsequent environmental document in accordance with Section 15162 of the State CEQA Guidelines (14 Cal. Code Regs. § 15000 et seq.).
