RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN PABLO AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE CONTRACT CHANGE ORDER (CCO) #1 UNDER AN EXISTING AGREEMENT WITH SPECTRASYSTEMS, INC. FOR THE REPLACEMENT OF POUR-IN-PLACE RUBBER PLAY SURFACE PADS AT THE COMMUNITY CENTER TOT LOT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$35,440, FOR A REVISED TOTAL CONTRACT AUTHORIZATION NOT TO EXCEED OF \$93,708

WHEREAS, the Public Works Department is responsible for the daily maintenance and repair of City-owned infrastructure, including parks and recreation facilities;

WHEREAS, on April 21, 2025, the City Council adopted Resolution 2025-054, authorizing the City Manager to execute an agreement with Spectrasystems, Inc. for the replacement of pour-in-place rubber play surface pads at Davis Park, in the amount of \$50,668, plus a 15% contingency for a total contract authorization not to exceed \$58,268;

WHEREAS, the Community Center tot lot has been identified as needing similar replacements due to wear, cracking, and deterioration of its rubber play surface, which now poses a safety concern and reduces the usability of the playground;

WHEREAS, staff recommends that City Council authorize the City Manager to execute Contract Change Order (CCO) #1 under the existing agreement with Spectrasystems, Inc. to include the replacement of pour-in-place rubber play surface pads at the Community Center tot lot in the amount of \$35,440; and

WHEREAS, the revised contract authorization, inclusive of work at both Davis Park and the Community Center, will total an amount not to exceed \$93,708.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of San Pablo as follows:

1. The City Manager is hereby authorized to execute Contract Change Order #1 under the existing agreement with Spectrasystems, Inc. in the amount of \$35,440 for the replacement of pour-in-place rubber play surface pads at the Community Center tot lot;
2. The revised total contract authorization for the agreement with Spectrasystems, Inc., inclusive of the Davis Park and Community Center projects, shall not exceed \$93,708; and

3. Funding for the Community Center work shall be made from the FY2025-26 Public Works Operating Budget (100-3410-43600 and 237-3610-43600).

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of San Pablo hereby finds that the foregoing recitations are true and correct and are included herein by reference as findings.
