

## RESOLUTION 2026-###

### **RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN PABLO (1) ACCEPTING AND APPROPRIATING GRANT FUNDS FROM THE CALIFORNIA NATURAL RESOURCES AGENCY TO THE MCNEIL PARK PROJECT (0501) IN THE AMOUNT OF \$1,000,000; AND (2) AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE ADDITIONAL AGREEMENTS REASONABLY NECESSARY TO EFFECTUATE THE CITY'S RECEIPT OF SUCH FUNDS**

WHEREAS, the Legislature and Governor of the State of California have approved a grant for the McNeil Park Project;

WHEREAS, the California Natural Resources Agency has been delegated responsibility for administration of the grant project, including setting up necessary procedures;

WHEREAS, the procedures established by the California Natural Resources Agency require the City, as grantee, to certify by resolution the approval of a Project Information Package before submission of said package to the State; and

WHEREAS the City will enter into an agreement with the State of California for the above project.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of San Pablo hereby:

1. Approves the acceptance of a general fund allocation for local assistance for the above project(s) and accepts to Fund 320-0501-33404-CNR-226 to appropriate in Fund 320-0501-43604-CNR-226;
2. Certifies the City understands the assurances and certification in the Project Information Form;
3. Certifies the City will have sufficient funds to acquire and/or develop, operate and maintain the project consistent with the land tenure requirements of the Grant Agreement; or will secure the resources to do so;
4. Certifies the City will comply with the prevailing wage provisions of the California Labor Code;
5. If applicable, certifies the project will comply with any laws and regulation including, but not limited to, the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), legal requirements for building codes, health and safety codes, disabled access laws, environmental laws and, that prior to commencement of construction, all applicable licenses and permits will have been obtained; and
6. Appoints the City Manager, or designee, as agent to conduct all negotiations, execute and submit all documents including, but not limited to the Project Information Form,

agreements, payment requests and so on, which may be necessary for the completion of the aforementioned project(s).

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Manager is authorized to execute any other related agreements, all in a form to be approved by the City Attorney, and to take such other actions as may be reasonably necessary to effectuate the City's receipt of the grant funding described in this resolution; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the foregoing recitations are true and correct and are included herein by reference as findings.
