

## RESOLUTION 2026-###

### RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN PABLO APPROVING AMENDMENT #1 TO CITY COUNCILMEMBER APPOINTMENTS BY MAYOR PABON-ALVARADO OF INDIVIDUAL CITY COUNCILMEMBERS TO ALL TEMPORARY AD-HOC SUBCOMMITTEES, STANDING COMMITTEES AND REGIONAL/LOCAL ASSIGNMENTS FOR CALENDAR YEAR 2026 PURSUANT TO SAN PABLO MUNICIPAL CODE SECTION 2.16.070, INCLUDING THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A TEMPORARY AD-HOC SUBCOMMITTEE FOR PROPOSED CITY-WIDE BEAUTIFICATION PLAN

WHEREAS, all City Councilmember assignments to newly established Temporary Ad-Hoc Subcommittees, Standing Committees, and Regional/Local Bodies for the upcoming Calendar Year 2026 (CY 2026) were affirmed in accordance with San Pablo Municipal Code (SPMC) 2.16.070 requirements on January 20, 2026, via Resolution 2026-007;

WHEREAS, annually, as City operational or policy needs arise, the City Council may establish by official City Council action a Temporary Ad-Hoc Subcommittee consisting of two (2) Councilmembers recommended by the Mayor and affirmed via majority vote per SPMC 2.16.070 requirements;

WHEREAS, as Proposed Amendment #1, following City Council action on January 20, 2026, via Resolution 2026-007, the City Manager recommends the formal establishment of the following Temporary Ad-Hoc Subcommittee, as follows:

(1) **City-wide Beautification Plan Temporary Ad-Hoc Subcommittee:**

*(Councilmembers Assigned: Pabon-Alvarado; Ponce)*

- **Purpose/Scope:** To represent the City Council on development of the proposed City-wide Beautification Plan for FY 2027-2029, and work directly with City Manager, project engineer/consultant and City staff on review and recommendations to the City Council prior to formal approval and funding appropriation, and to ensure compliance with all relevant Public Contract Code (PCC) requirements.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED the City Council of the City of San Pablo hereby authorizes and approves the following, as follows:

1. The City Council approves all recommendations for appointments of individual City Councilmembers to designated City Council Temporary Ad-Hoc Subcommittees, Standing Committees, and Regional/Local bodies for Calendar Year 2026 affirmed by majority vote via adopted Resolution 2026-007 on January 20, 2026, and as set forth on Exhibits 1 and 2.
2. The City Council authorizes and approves the formal establishment of a

Temporary Ad-Hoc Subcommittee dedicated to the development of the proposed City-wide Beautification Plan following formal majority vote direction via minute order received from the City Council on January 20, 2026.

3. Mayor Pabon-Alvarado has recommended appointing the Mayor and Councilmember Ponce to serve on this Ad-Hoc Subcommittee dedicated to the development of the proposed City-wide Beautification Plan until its expiration by December 31, 2026, in order to ensure compliance with all applicable Brown Act requirements.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the foregoing recitations are true and correct, and are included herein by reference as findings.
