RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN PABLO (1) ACCEPTING AND APPROPRIATING COMMUNITY PROJECT FUNDED CONGRESSIONAL DIRECTED SPENDING (CPFCDs) PROGRAM FUNDS FROM U.S. CONGRESSMAN JOHN GARAMENDI TO THE SAN PABLO AVENUE BRIDGE REPLACEMENT PROJECT (0202) IN THE AMOUNT OF \$850,000; (2) RECOGNIZING THAT THE CPFCDs REQUIRED MATCH WILL BE ALLOCATED AS PART OF THE FY 2025-26 MID-CYCLE CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM (CIP) BUDGET AMENDMENT TO THE SAN PABLO AVENUE BRIDGE REPLACEMENT PROJECT (0202) IN THE AMOUNT OF \$110,127; AND (3) AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE ALL AGREEMENTS AND AMENDMENTS RELATED TO THE GRANT

WHEREAS, the San Pablo Avenue Bridge (State Bridge No. 28C0057) was constructed in 1926 located at the convergence of San Pablo Avenue, 23rd Street, and Road 20. The existing bridge has been classified as both “Structurally Deficient” and “Functionally Obsolete” due to:

- Inadequate lane widths that do not meet the AASHTO (American Association of State Highway and Transportation Officials) standards;
- Insufficient roadway clearance; and
- Inability to safely accommodate current Average Daily Traffic (ADT) volumes;

WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution 2016-014 adopted on February 1, 2016, the City Council authorized Public Works to apply for Highway Bridge Program funds to replace the bridge;

WHEREAS, through previous City Council funding approvals, multiple funding sources for the Project including Highway Bridge Program (HBP) Grant Funds, WCCTAC Subregional Transportation Mitigation Program (STMP) Grant Funds and Local General Fund matches;

WHEREAS, in March 2024 the City submitted a request for Community Project Funding (formerly known as “earmark funds”) through Congressman John Garamendi for \$850,000;

WHEREAS, to receive CPFCDs funds applications were submitted to the Metropolitan Transportation Commission (MTC) and Caltrans, and were evaluated for transparency;

WHEREAS, on August 15, 2025, Caltrans issued the E-76 authorization, formally approving the CPFCDs funds with a federal reimbursement ratio of 88.53%, and therefore, the local match required is 11.47% or \$110,127; and

WHEREAS, staff recommends acceptance of the CPFCDs funds in the amount of \$850,000; formal recognition that there is a required a local match; and authorization to enter into any agreements related to the program; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of San Pablo hereby:

- (1) accepts and appropriates the CPFCDs funding in the amount of \$850,000 to the San Pablo Bridge Replacement Project (0202);
- (2) recognizes that the required CPFCDs local match in the amount of \$110,127 will to be formally allocated through the FY 2025-26 Mid-cycle CIP Budget Amendment; and
- (3) authorizes the City Manager to execute all necessary agreements and amendments related to the grant in a form to be approved by the City Attorney.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the foregoing recitations are true and correct and are included herein by reference as findings.
