RE: PROTECTING STATE OF CA FUNDING APPROPRIATIONS FOR CITY OF SAN PABLO

Dear State Legislators:

As Mayor, on behalf of the San Pablo City Council, I am forwarding a list compiled of funding appropriations and grants received by the City of San Pablo (City) from the State of CA since 2021 that have been formally accepted, appropriated and expense applied toward critical capital projects and City programs/services for the San Pablo community. (See Attachment)

To date, all State of CA funding appropriations/grants have been formally received by the City and are being actively expended and/or slated for construction award in the next 6-12 month period for a number of critical City capital projects currently active and underway as part of our ongoing, multi-year project management and planning efforts.

Please understand that the City of San Pablo is extremely grateful for State funding opportunities which have been vigorously pursued by a cadre of City staff, our lobbyist, and consultants, and jointly supported over the years by our State Legislators' individual efforts to secure these funding opportunities for our City.

As you know, San Pablo is a small, low-income, socio-economic impacted community which relies heavily on State funding to assist in providing critical funding gaps for major infrastructure, essential community health programs/services, and providing new park facilities for our local residents, including meeting compliance with increased State CA regulatory requirements.

In closing, San Pablo sincerely requests our State Legislators continue to **strongly advocate** for protecting State funding appropriations already awarded to local cities in your respective Districts which took multiple years of advanced advocacy and planning to obtain this important resource for our local communities.
