RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN PABLO AMENDING THE FY 2018-21 CITY COUNCIL PRIORITY WORKPLAN TO INCLUDE A NEW INITIATIVE: SERVICES FOR FAMILIES, SENIORS AND YOUTH: POLICY TO REDUCE PROMOTION OF UNHEALTHY TOBACCO PRODUCTS TO YOUTH, SUCH AS PROHIBITING THE SALE OF FLAVORED TOBACCO PRODUCTS, AND TO LIMIT TOBACCO RETAIL ACCESS NEAR SAN PABLO SCHOOLS

WHEREAS, the City Council Adopted Priority Workplan (Workplan) is a culmination of previous goal-setting and strategic planning sessions involving previous and current City Council, City Manager, Executive Leadership Group members, and shall be annually updated to reflect current City Council priorities and policy areas; and

WHEREAS, it is highly recommended by the City Manager to develop an annual WORKPLAN to prioritize and re-focus among competing priorities to enhance operational efficiency and staff productivity for City service delivery; and

WHEREAS, the City Council affirmed all final recommended policy items from previous City Council deliberations, from the City Manager's and the City's consultant, Management Partners, Inc. recommendations, and solicited public input during two (2) scheduled Study Session/Council workshop held during November 2017, and that these recommended policy items by unanimous minute action vote were incorporated into the Final Workplan Update for final City Council adoption on November 4, 2017, via Resolution 2017-213; and became effective as of November 1, 2017; and

WHEREAS, the City Council from time to time may consider formally amending the Final Workplan with adopted policy items by majority vote of the City Council;

POLICY AREA: SERVICES FOR FAMILIES, SENIORS AND YOUTH

Add: Policy to reduce promotion of unhealthy tobacco products to youth, such as prohibiting the sale of flavored tobacco products, and the number of stores that seek these products near San Pablo schools.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED the City Council of the City of San Pablo hereby amends the FY 2018-21 City Council Priority Workplan effective this date by said Resolution.

POLICY AREA: SERVICES FOR FAMILIES, SENIORS AND YOUTH

Add: Policy to reduce promotion of unhealthy tobacco products to youth, such as prohibiting the sale of flavored tobacco products, and to limit tobacco retail access near San Pablo schools
