

## RESOLUTION 2018-162

### **RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN PABLO AUTHORIZING THE APPROPRIATION OF \$60,000 FROM SUPPLEMENTAL LAW ENFORCEMENT SERVICES GRANT REVENUES TO SPENDABLE ACCOUNTS IN THE POLICE DEPARTMENT'S GENERAL FUND BUDGET 100-2110-43600 TO OUTFIT THE REGIONAL TRAINING CENTER**

WHEREAS, *Establish Professional Standards and Training Unit and Technology Improvements* under the Public Safety Policy Area is an adopted policy item under the FY 2018-21 City Council Priority Work plan, effective November 1, 2017;

WHEREAS, the Supplemental Law Enforcement Services Grant is a mandated grant as defined by Government Code 30061(b)(3)(i) wherein the County shall remit at minimum \$100,000 annually to be spent on frontline law enforcement. Grant revenues have accumulated and are available for appropriation;

WHEREAS, this proposed action is not a project under CEQA pursuant to Guidelines Section 15378(b)(2): Continuing administrative or maintenance activities, such as purchases for supplies, personnel-related actions, general policy and procedure making.

WHEREAS, the City of San Pablo recently acquired use of 2300 El Portal Drive Suite C which the Police Department will use as a Regional Training Center.

WHEREAS, the facility is currently not operational, and will require outfitting infrastructure to include but not be limited to procurements of: furniture, technology/computer software, security cameras, and training materials;

WHEREAS, the completed outfitted Regional Training Center will allow the Police Department to conduct internal trainings as well as host trainings for neighboring agencies; and;

WHEREAS, all procurement of equipment and materials related to the operational needs of the Regional Training Center, as it relates to this funding appropriation, will be completed within the 2018/19 fiscal year and will follow all procurement processes outlined in Chapter 3.16 of the Municipal Code.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of San Pablo hereby authorizes the appropriation of \$60,000 from Supplemental Law Enforcement Services grant revenues (Fund 210) to spendable accounts in the Police Department's General Fund budget (100-2110-43600) to outfit the Regional Training Center.
