RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN PABLO AUTHORIZING A MAPLE HALL RENTAL FEE WAIVER IN THE AMOUNT OF \$1,005 FOR THE LATINA CENTER'S WOMEN'S HEALTH LEADERSHIP AND YOUNG LATIN FUTURE LEADERS PROGRAMS GRADUATION

WHEREAS, *Enhance Community Resilience and Build a Healthy Community* are adopted policy items under the FY 2023-25 Council Priority Workplan, effective May 1, 2023;

WHEREAS, this proposed action is not a project defined by CEQA;

WHEREAS, the City Manager received a letter dated June 13, 2024 from Miriam Wong, Executive Director of The Latina Center, requesting the waiver of rental fees for the use of Maple Hall at the San Pablo City Hall for the graduation ceremony for their Women's Health Leadership and Young Latin Future Leaders programs on Saturday, July 13, 2024;

WHEREAS, the leadership programs proved by The Latina Center are designed to empower women and youth within the Latino communities;

WHEREAS, each year, The Latina Center has 25 graduates from West Contra Costa from their leadership programs;

WHEREAS, The Latina Center is requesting the use of Maple Hall for 5 hours;

WHEREAS, The Latina Center is asking the San Pablo City Council to authorize a waiver of the \$1,005 rental fee for its use of Maple Hall at San Pablo City Hall; and

WHEREAS, The Latina Center will provide adequate liability insurance associated with the use of the facility, and pay for the Building Attendant staffing fees and Security Guard fees;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of San Pablo hereby authorizes the fee waiver in the amount of \$1,005 for The Latina Center's Women's Health Leadership and Young Latin Future Leaders Programs graduation; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the foregoing recitations are true and correct and are included herein by reference as findings.
