

**RESOLUTION 2020-121**

**RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN PABLO TO RATIFY THE CITY OF SAN PABLO'S GRANT APPLICATION FOR \$1.56 MILLION IN FUNDS FROM THE CALIFORNIA STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD PROPOSITION 1 FUNDING**

WHEREAS, California State Water Resources Control Board has \$200 million in funding for the Storm Water Grant Program (SWGP);

WHEREAS, the goal of the SWGP is to improve regional water self-reliance, security, and adapt to the effects on water supply arising from climate change;

WHEREAS, the City of San Pablo is an eligible entity to apply for California State Water Resources Control Board SWGP funds;

WHEREAS, the City of San Pablo's Sutter Avenue Green Street Project is a multi-benefit project that would reduce localized urban flooding, calm traffic, encourage active modes of transportation, improve water quality, increase infiltration, sequester carbon and provide urban greening; and

WHEREAS, the City applied for \$1.56 million in funding from the SWGP for the Sutter Avenue Green Street Project on June 30, 2020.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of San Pablo hereby ratifies the grant application submittal for \$1.56 million in Proposition 1 funding from the California State Water Resources Control Board for the Storm Water Grant Program.
