

**SECOND AMENDMENT TO AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF SAN PABLO AND
PUBLIC PROFIT**
Agreement No. YC17-1001

THIS SECOND AMENDMENT TO AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF SAN PABLO AND PUBLIC PROFIT for consulting services is entered into this 5th day of August, 2019, by and between the CITY OF SAN PABLO, a municipal corporation ("City") and Public Profit ("Consultant").

R E C I T A L S

WHEREAS, on July 3, 2017, CITY and Consultant entered into an Agreement to provide evaluation of the San Pablo Community Schools Initiative (SPCSI), the SPCSI grant program—San Pablo Team for Youth (TFY), the San Pablo Youth Commission, Girls Circle, and Measure Q supported activities in San Pablo public schools, herein collectively referred to as "Providers" and to obtain services for Measure Q and Measure K reporting ("Agreement"); and

WHEREAS, on June 4, 2018, CITY and Agency entered into the First Amendment to Agreement for fiscal year 2018-19 to pay Agency an additional \$8,798 for a contract amount of \$87,943; and

WHEREAS, the parties have agreed to modify the term of the Agreement related to term, scope of services, and compensation;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE PARTIES DO MUTUALLY AGREE AS FOLLOWS:

1. **SCOPE OF SERVICES**. Section 1 of the Agreement, "Scope of Services" and Exhibit A "Scope of Services" are amended to include the following provision:

"Consultant agrees to provide evaluation services to the City in conformance with the proposal submitted by Consultant, Scope of Services, **dated June 24, 2019** (Exhibit A), and the cost proposal submitted by Consultant, and reflected in the Reporting Requirements, (Exhibit B), all of which are attached and incorporated herein by reference. In the event of any discrepancy between any of the terms of Consultant's proposal and this agreement, the terms most favorable to the City shall prevail."

2. **COMPENSATION**. Section 2 of the Agreement, "Compensation" is amended to include the following provision:

"For fiscal year 2019-20, CITY shall pay Consultant an additional \$6,457.00 for a total compensation not to exceed Ninety-Four Thousand Four Hundred Dollars and No Cents (\$94,400.00)."

3. **TERM**. Section 4 of the Agreement, "Effective Date and Term" is amended to include the following provision:

"The effective date of this Second Amendment to the Agreement is August 5, 2019 and it shall terminate on October 31, 2020."

4. All other terms and conditions of the Agreement shall remain in full force and effect.

EXHIBIT A

SCOPE OF SERVICES

INTRODUCTION

Public Profit helps youth service organizations measure and manage what matters. Public Profit is committed to improving the effectiveness of public service organizations through the effective use of information. They provide high-quality, cost-effective consulting services to nonprofits, governments, and schools.

PROGRAM DESCRIPTION

Public Profit will assist the City of San Pablo in **Evaluating the San Pablo Beacon Community Schools Initiative**. The goal of the design is to evaluate the impact of services on youth. Public Profit will evaluate the implementation of San Pablo's five community schools grant strategies at six San Pablo schools: Bayview, Dover, Downer, Helms, Lake, and Riverside. The evaluation will take a comprehensive, holistic look at each individual school's implementation of the grants according to its school-specific goals. In addition, the evaluation includes city-funded Violence Prevention and Intervention programs at Richmond High School.

The evaluation will include the San Pablo Youth Commission and Measure Q supported activities. Evaluation reports are intended to promote continuous quality improvement and to provide the public with information about the quality and benefits of the programs.

Public Profit will also produce a **Measure Q Report**, **Measure K Report**, and **Childhood Obesity Prevention Advisory Group (COPAG) Report** to present to the City of San Pablo and respective Oversight Committees.

SCOPE OF WORK

Key deliverables for this scope of work include an evaluation plan, youth surveys, stakeholder interviews, and document review, and event and participation data. Data will be analyzed and summarized into a five to ten-page high level executive summary, an at-a-glance summary infographic, seven school profiles, a summer program profile.
