This meeting is being held in accordance with the Brown Act as amended by Assembly Bill 361 pursuant to the determination of the City Council, set forth in Resolution 2022-140, dated September 19, 2022, that the City Council, Standing Committees, and Commissions subject to the Brown Act shall continue to meet remotely through tele-conference or video-conference given the following findings:

i. The COVID-19 pandemic continues to impact the ability of the City Council, its Standing Committees and Commissions, as well as the staff and members of the public, from meeting safely in person; and
