RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN PABLO REAPPROPRIATING AND OBLIGATING \$76,070.02 IN AMERICAN RESCUE PLAN ACT (ARPA) FUNDING (FUND 120) TO THE NEW SAN PABLO POLICE DEPARTMENT HEADQUARTERS AND REGIONAL TRAINING FACILITY PROJECT BUDGET (320-0104-43605-GFD-422) TO FUND TECHNOLOGY EXPENSES RELATED TO THE PROJECT

WHEREAS, this proposed action is not a project as defined by CEQA;

WHEREAS, on April 4, 2022, City Council adopted Resolution 2022-056 which, among other actions, appropriated \$100,000 in American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) funding under Fund 120 to Wireless/Fiber/Broadband Infrastructure Projects of which \$76,070.02 is left unspent;

WHEREAS, the City is currently building a New San Pablo Police Department Headquarters and Regional Training Facility (Project);

WHEREAS, on February 21, 2023, City Council adopted Resolution 2023-024 awarding the design-build contract for the design and construction of the Project to C. Overaa & Co. (Overaa); and

WHEREAS, this resolution is intended to reappropriate and obligate the remaining \$76,070.02 in ARPA funds under Fund 120 to the Project budget to fund technology equipment, infrastructure and fiber optic expenses related to the Project, which is part of the scope of the Overaa contract.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the foregoing recitations are true and correct, and are included herein by reference as findings; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of San Pablo hereby authorizes the reappropriation and obligation of \$76,070.02 in ARPA funds under Fund 120 to the Project budget 320-0104-43605-GFD-422 to fund a portion of the Overaa contract pertaining to technology equipment, infrastructure and fiber optic expenses related the New San Pablo Police Department Headquarters and Regional Training Facility (Project).
