## RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN PABLO AUTHORIZING AN APPLICATION FOR \$2.5 MILLION IN GRANT FUNDS FOR CALIFORNIA CLIMATE INVESTMENTS URBAN GREENING PROGRAM

WHEREAS, the Legislature and Governor of the State of California have provided funds for the California Climate Investments Urban Greening program shown above;

WHEREAS, the California Natural Resources Agency has been delegated the responsibility for the administration of this grant program, establishing necessary procedures;

WHEREAS, the procedures established by the California Natural Resources Agency require a resolution certifying the approval of application(s) by the Applicant's governing board before submitting the application(s) to the State; and

WHEREAS, the applicant, if selected, will enter into an agreement with the State of California to carry out the Project, and will return to City Council to accept, appropriate and if required request matching funds.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of San Pablo:

- 1. Approves the filing of an application for the Rumrill Phase II and San Pablo Community Urban Tree Project;
- 2. Certifies that applicant understands the assurances and certification in the application, and
- 3. Certifies that applicant or title holder will have sufficient funds to operate and maintain the project consistent with the land tenure requirements; or will secure the resources to do so, and
- 4. Certifies that it will comply with the provisions of Section 1771.5 of the State Labor Code, and
- 5. If applicable, certifies that the project will comply with any laws and regulations including, but not limited to, legal requirements for building codes, health and safety codes, disabled access laws, environmental laws and, that prior to commencement of construction, all applicable permits will have been obtained, and

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- 6. Certifies that applicant will work towards the Governor's State Planning Priorities intended to promote equity, strengthen the economy, protect the environment, and promote public health and safety as included in Government Code Section 65041.1, and
- 7. Appoints the City Manager, or designee, as agent to conduct all negotiations, execute and submit all documents including, but not limited to applications, agreements, and payment requests and so on, which may be necessary for the completion of the aforementioned project.
