To whom it may concern,

The owners of Ocotes Grill, LLC, a restaurant located at 1439 23rd Street, Unit A, San Pablo, are requesting TYPE 41 – Beer & Wine On-Sale General Eating Place license.

Business purpose:

Ocotes Grill, LLC is a public eating establishment serving "bistro" styled Mexican American cuisine with table service of approximately 50 seated guests. Our restaurant will operate from 9:00 AM to 10:00 PM, Monday – Sunday, we will only be closed for special arrangements. The restaurant will have private dining area seating.

Products and services:

As with other restaurants of this style, both food and beverage are integral to the business plan and the overall environment of the restaurant. The recipes and menu items are prepared with consideration to the consumption of spirits, such as wines and beers to compliment the meal. We intend to provide our guests with a full range of culinary experience. In our experience, we have seen customers turn away unique, quality food due to non-sales of alcohol beverages.

Revenue and management:

We expect that approximately 70% of revenue to come from food, 15% from alcohol, and 15% from non-alcohol beverage sales. The management of Ocotes Grill, LLC are well suited and experienced in the restaurant industry. The staff of Ocotes Grill, LLC will be well trained for food safety, and beverage service. On average we expect that 3 floor staff, 3 kitchen staff, beverage staff over the age of 21 and 2 managers will be present during operating hours. Management and beverage staff will have any required ABC training.




