RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN PABLO AUTHORIZING THE SAN PABLO POLICE DEPARTMENT TO ACCEPT AND APPROPRIATE \$100,000 IN GRANT FUNDING FROM THE CALIFORNIA ALCOHOL BEVERAGE CONTROL TO PARTICIPATE IN THE GRANT ASSISTANCE TO LOCAL LAW ENFORCEMENT PROGRAM TO DEVELOP AN EFFECTIVE, COMPREHENSIVE AND STRATEGIC APPROACH TO ELIMINATING THE CRIME AND PUBLIC NUISANCE PROBLEMS ASSOCIATED WITH PROBLEM ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE OUTLETS

WHEREAS, Budget Spending Controls is an adopted policy item under the FY 2015-17 Council Priority Work Plan, effective October 1, 2016. In addition, Community Outreach and Priority Oriented Policing Program are adopted policy items under Public Safety in the Work Plan;

WHEREAS, the Priority Oriented Policing (POP) Unit is tasked with working with local businesses and residents to address priority issues which impact our community. These issues include addressing licensed alcohol establishments within San Pablo and the crime associated to alcohol in those areas;

WHEREAS, this is not a project as defined by CEQA;

WHEREAS, the City of San Pablo has 61 alcohol outlets within 2.6 square miles. The large majority of problem licensees are concentrated in areas that have both the highest crime rates and the greatest number of off-sale premises, (alcohol sold to be consumed off the premises; such as liquor stores);

WHEREAS, the San Pablo Police Department was selected by the California Alcohol Beverage Control ("ABC") and funding is available to participate in the "Grant Assistance to Local Law Enforcement Program";

WHEREAS, the City of San Pablo supports the grant goals and wishes to participate in the "Grant Assistance to Local Law Enforcement Program";

WHEREAS, in past years, the City of San Pablo successfully entered into agreements with the California Alcohol Beverage Control as part of their "Grant Assistance to Local Law Enforcement Program";

WHEREAS, funds are provided for the purchase of equipment, overtime pay for enforcement operations, and registration/travel expenses for ABC enforcement training. Additionally, the POP Unit will conduct inspections and provide training to local business owners on relevant issues, laws, and responsibilities of licensed alcohol establishments. The 2017 ABC grant period is from July 1, 2017 through June 30, 2018; and

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WHEREAS, the total amount of ABC provided grant funding is \$100,000.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the foregoing recitations are true and correct, and are included herein by reference as findings.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Council authorizes the City Manager to accept the grant and appropriate funds anticipated to be received from the California Alcohol Beverage Control to be used exclusively for the purpose of ABC related enforcement, training, and education as follows:
