

RESOLUTION 2017-190

RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN PABLO (1) AWARDING THE BID FOR THE 2017/18 PAVEMENT REPAIR PROJECT (PAV-018) TO PAVING CONSTRUCTION SERVICES, INC. AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$389,214 WITH PAVING CONSTRUCTION SERVICES, INC. WITH A 25% CONTINGENCY FOR A TOTAL AUTHORIZATION OF \$486,517; AND (2) IDENTIFYING PAV-018 AS SB1 ROAD REPAIR AND ACCOUNTABILITY ACT MAINTENANCE-OF-EFFORT PROJECT IN AN AMOUNT EQUAL TO OR GREATER THAN \$464,941

WHEREAS; the 2017-18 Pavement Repair Project, PAV-018, is part of the City's ongoing pavement maintenance program in the capital projects budget;

WHEREAS, the City of San Pablo has filed a Notice of Exemption for the project with the Contra Costa County Clerk on September 12, 2017 as repairs and maintenance to existing facilities;

WHEREAS, the City has solicited public bids for the construction of the project in conformance with the formal bidding requirements of State Law and City ordinances, and opened the bids on September 18, 2017;

WHEREAS, the scope of work includes, but is not limited to, base failure repairs of existing asphalt concrete, overlaying the existing asphalt concrete pavement with conventional asphalt concrete, constructing concrete curb ramps and placement of striping on the following streets:

1. Lake St., from San Pablo Ave. to 19th St.
2. 20th St., from Lake St. to Broadway Ave.
3. 14th St., from Rivers St. to Rheem Creek
4. Manor Dr., from Brookside Dr. to Marelia Ct.
5. Marelia Ct., from Manor Dr. to Rumrill Blvd.

WHEREAS, three bids were received;

WHEREAS, the lowest responsive and responsible bid was submitted by Paving Construction Services, Inc. of California;

WHEREAS, funds to cover this cost are already budgeted in the approved capital project budget under Pavement Rehabilitation/Management project, 320-3200-43600-PAV-018;

WHEREAS, SB1 the Road Repair and Accountability Act of 2017 requires \$464,941 of discretionary funds be spent on road maintenance to comply with the maintenance of effort (MOE) requirement; and,

WHEREAS, PAV-018 is a pavement repair, or road maintenance project with a total authorization of \$486,517, which meets the MOE requirement.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that City Council of the City of San Pablo hereby awards the bid for the 2017/18 Pavement Repair Project, PAV-018, and authorizes the City Manager to execute an agreement in the amount of \$389,214 with Paving Construction Services, Inc. with an available contingency of approximately 25% for a total authorization of \$486,517.
