Replace 20 Ton Box Car unit

Per request of the San Pablo PD maintenance department, to evaluate the equipment serving the first floor of San Pablo Police Department located at 13880 San Pablo Ave in San Pablo CA. The unit serving this area was diagnosed with a multiple leaks in the refrigerant cycle. This unit has several major issues and is underperforming. This unit is a 1996 Carrier 20 ton cooling only package unit with an exisiting powered economizer system. In our opinion at this time replacement of this equipment is strongly recommended as this equipment is no longer cost effective to continue to perform major repairs and has become very inefficient. The unit is currently struggling to keep up.

We propose the following:

Remove and dispose of existing Carrier 20 ton unit

Replace with new Carrier 20 ton cooling only package unit with powered economizer

Provide adaptation to existing electrical connections

Provide adaptation to existing condensate drain assembly

Provide adaptation to existing sheet metal duct connections as needed.

Test & operate new air conditioning unit.

Report any duct, electrical, or plumbing, discrepancies, quote for repair if required.

Customer agrees that the contractor reserves the right to abandon the job for nonpayment and any funds, materials and equipment remain the property of SH Mechanical Inc. SH Mechanical Inc. is not responsible for any product that is damaged, spoiled or made unacceptable should any part of the mechanical system fail. Terms: Past dues payments are subject to a 1.5% per month (18% per annum) service charge. Proposal is valid for 30 days.

- Maintenance after completion of scope of work, unless contracted with us directly.
- Additional refrigerant needed after recovery to insure proper operation
- Demolition of electrical or reinstallation of line, control or sensor wiring
- Structural and Mechanical engineering. This includes the design, installation or recommendation of footings, foundations, concrete and rebar support or any associated work and materials.
- Additional City, County, State and or Federal assessments or requirements.
- Additional work if determined by City, County, State and or Federal entity.
- Any additional materials or labor not otherwise notes in the above listed "Scope of Work" Inclusions and Notes:

All materials provided shall be installed in a new (unless noted) and undamaged condition. All work shall be performed in a professional and workman-like manner in accordance with approved plans and specifications.

All trades contracting on the same project are to be licensed by the Contractors State License Board in the state of California for the respective trade and maintain proper insurance. They must be willing and able to provide copies of both license and insurance. If the construction and or facility schedule is delayed causing the need to perform our scope of work other than during the normal work day, the overtime and or double time portion of the labor will be billed as an extra to the contract. Any additional costs incurred by SH Mechanical Inc. due to changes in scheduling will be billed as an extra to the contract. This agreement is contingent upon strikes, accidents, or delays beyond our control. Owners to carry all necessary insurance. Our
