PROCLAMATION

"NATIONAL PUBLIC WORKS WEEK" May 20 through May 27, 2018

WHEREAS, the year 2018 marks the 58th annual National Public Works Week.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Genoveva Garcia Calloway, Mayor, and on behalf of the San Pablo City Council, do hereby proclaim May 20 through May 27, 2018 as "National Public Works Week," and I call upon all citizens and civic organizations to acquaint themselves with the issues involved in providing our public works and to recognize the contributions which Public Works officials make every day to our health, safety, comfort and quality of life.
