RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN PABLO AMENDING THE FY 2018-21 CITY COUNCIL PRIORITY WORKPLAN TO INCLUDE A NEW POLICY FOR CONSIDERATION, UNDER SERVICES FOR FAMILIES, SENIORS AND YOUTH: TO EXPLORE BUDGET IMPACT AND OPERATIONAL FEASIBILITY OF EXPANDING CITY SERVICES FOR AFTER HOURS PUBLIC USE OF CITY RESTROOM FACILITIES IN CITY PARKS
