RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN PABLO AUTHORIZING AN EVENT SPONSORSHIP IN FISCAL YEAR 2018/19 IN THE AMOUNT OF \$2,000 TO THE BOYS & GIRLS CLUB OF CONTRA COSTA FOR THEIR “OPEN THE DOOR TO A GREAT FUTURE” BREAKFAST EVENT ON THURSDAY, NOVEMBER 1, 2018

WHEREAS, *Fiscal Resiliency Policies: Spending Cap & Facility Use Policy for Maple Hall Waivers and Spending Cap & Special Events Sponsorship (Discretionary Spending)* are adopted policy items under the FY 2018-21 Council Priority Workplan effective November 1, 2017, the sponsorship also falls under 601.12 *Teen Leadership Mentoring Program* under policy item Services for Families, Seniors and Youth 601;

WHEREAS, this is not a project as defined by CEQA;

WHEREAS, On September 24, 2018 the City Manager received a letter from Ms. Lorna Padia Markus, Great Futures Breakfast Chair for the Boys & Girls Club of Contra Costa, in El Sobrante;

WHEREAS, the Boys & Girls Clubs of El Sobrante and The Diablo Valley unified as one organization in 2017 in support of a vision to serve more youth with a greater impact throughout Contra Costa County;

WHEREAS, their breakfast event “*Open the Door to a Great Future*” will be held on Thursday, November 1, 2018 at the Crockett Community Center in Crockett, CA;

WHEREAS, the Master of Ceremonies is Dick Callahan, current announcer for the Oakland A’s and former announcer for the Golden State Warriors and the Keynote Speaker is Dave Stewart, MLB All-Star and former member of the Boys & Girls Club;

WHEREAS, attendees will have an opportunity to hear inspiring stories from community and business honorees as well as the youth of the year candidate;

WHEREAS, the Boys & Girls Clubs of America began in 1860 with three women in Hartford, Connecticut - Mary Goodwin, Alice Goodwin and Elizabeth Hammersley. believing that boys who roamed the streets should have a positive alternative, they organized the first Club;

WHEREAS, with character development as the cornerstone of the experience, the Club focused on capturing boys’ interests, improving their behavior and increasing their personal expectations and goals;

WHEREAS, a cause was born and 157 years later the Boys & Girls Club provides students a safe place to go after school and during the summer while providing a positive and enriching experience that places students on a path to success;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of San Pablo authorizes the *“Open the Door to a Great Future”* sponsorship level in the amount of \$2,000. Sponsorship includes eight (8) tickets to the fundraising breakfast event, recognition on press releases, website as well as on the event program material; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED A total of \$30,000 has been budgeted and earmarked for Event Annual Sponsorship for FY2018/19 under the Adopted FY 2018/21 Quadrennial Operating Budget – City Council Department (100-1110-44050). The authorized sponsorship in the amount of \$2,500 will be deducted from this expense balance leaving a remaining balance of \$10,100 for the remainder of FY 2018/19 period for future sponsorships by the City Council.
