RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN PABLO AUTHORIZING A GRANT APPLICATION FOR \$5,000 FOR ONE DUAL-PORT ELECTRIC VEHICLE CHARGING STATION TO BE INSTALLED AT CITY HALL AND RATIFYING THE TRANSPORTATION FUND FOR CLEAN AIR FUNDING AGREEMENT WITH THE WEST CONTRA COSTA TRANSPORTATION ADVISORY COMMITTEE FOR \$6,000 TO PURCHASE AND INSTALL TWO DUAL-PORT ELECTRIC VEHICLE CHARGING STATIONS AT THE NEW CITY OF SAN PABLO CITY HALL

WHEREAS, demand for the existing electric vehicle (EV) charging station at City Hall exceeds is availability;

WHEREAS, Marin Clean Energy (MCE) offers partial funding for the purchase and installation of EV chargers;

WHEREAS, the Bay Area Air Quality Management District (BAAQMD) has established a grant fund, entitled the Transportation Fund for Clean Air ("TFCA") to implement mobile source and transportation control projects that result in surplus emission reduction;

WHEREAS, the West Contra Costa Transportation Advisory Committee (WCCTAC) is authorized by BAAQMD to identify projects that are eligible for funding from the TFCA Program and to disburse TFCA funds to such projects;

WHEREAS, the installation of EV charging stations at the current City Hall and at the new City Hall supports the greenhouse gas reduction strategies outlined in the City's Climate Action Plan in Strategies B1, T1 and T1;

WHEREAS, the installation of EV charging stations at the new City Hall proactively responds to high EV charging demand, as demonstrated through City EV fleet requirements, City staff EV usage, anticipated City staff EV charging demand, and high usage rates of EV charging stations at the existing City Hall;

WHEREAS, the availability of outside funding support for the purchase and installation of EV charging stations has enabled the City to increase the number of EV charging stations to be installed as part of the New City Hall Project;

WHEREAS, once grant funding is secured for both the current City Hall and new City Hall EV charging station projects and project costs have been adequately calculated, staff will return to City Council to appropriate necessary funding.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the foregoing recitations are true and correct, and are included herein by reference as findings;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of San Pablo

authorizes staff to apply for a \$5,000 grant to purchase and install a new dual-port EV charging station at current City Hall and hereby ratifies the TFCA Funding Agreement with WCCTAC, signed by the Public Works Director on November 15, 2018, for \$6,000 to purchase and install two dual-port electric vehicle charging stations at the new City of San Pablo City Hall.
