

## **RESOLUTION SPEDC2019-002**

### **RESOLUTION OF THE SAN PABLO ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT CORPORATION BOARD OF DIRECTORS AUTHORIZING A CHARITABLE SPONSORSHIP IN THE AMOUNT OF \$2,500 FOR THE CONTRA COSTA COMMUNITY COLLEGE FOOD & WINE EVENT**

WHEREAS, as the Board of Directors (Board) is aware, San Pablo Economic Development Corporation (San Pablo EDC) continues to cultivate a partnership with Contra Costa Community College (College). The San Pablo EDC has a formal memorandum of understanding (MOU) with the College for career technical education (CTE) programs and Early Learning Center (ELC) for childcare, as well as participates in major events at the College, such as the West Contra Costa County Career Fair; and

WHEREAS, one of the College's signature events is the annual Food & Wine event, which supports the Culinary Arts Program through scholarships and culinary training abroad, and last year, these scholarships supported ten (10) students to travel to Italy for a two-week, multi-region, hands-on culinary instructional experience; and

WHEREAS, the most pertinent benefits for the San Pablo EDC are the support of local residents to study abroad, advancement of the College relationship, and the significant outreach staff is able to do at the event; and

WHEREAS, the event is slated for Sunday, April 28, 2019, from 11:00 AM to 2:30 PM at Fireside Hall on the College campus; and

WHEREAS, staff believe sponsorship of this event will have a positive economic impact on program trainees, the community, and the San Pablo EDC's brand, while allowing the San Pablo EDC to grow its brand exposure, distribution lists and partnership with the College; and

WHEREAS, the fiscal impact would be \$2,500 from FY18-19 expense account 60310 Charitable Sponsorships.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the San Pablo Economic Development Corporation Board of Directors, as follows:

- 1) Authorize a charitable sponsorship in the amount of \$2,500 for the contra costa community college food & wine event
