## **RESOLUTION 2019-044**

## RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN PABLO ADOPTING A LIST OF PROJECTS FOR FISCAL YEAR 2019/20 FUNDED BY SENATE BILL 1 (SB 1): THE ROAD REPAIR AND ACCOUNTABILITY ACT OF 2017

WHEREAS, Senate Bill 1 (SB 1), the Road Repair and Accountability Act of 2017 (Chapter 5, Statutes of 2017) was passed by the Legislature and Signed into law by the Governor in April 2017 to address the significant multi-modal transportation funding shortfalls statewide:

WHEREAS, SB 1 includes accountability and transparency provisions that will ensure the residents of our City are aware of the projects proposed for funding in our community and which projects have been completed each fiscal year;

WHEREAS, the City must adopt by resolution a list of projects proposed to receive fiscal year funding from the Road Maintenance and Rehabilitation Account (RMRA), created by SB 1, which must include a description and the location of each proposed project, a proposed schedule for the project's completion, and the estimated useful life of the improvement;

WHEREAS, the City, will receive an estimated \$522,916 in RMRA funding in Fiscal Year 2019/20 from SB 1;

WHEREAS, this is the third year in which the City is receiving SB 1 funding and will enable the City to continue essential road maintenance and rehabilitation projects, safety improvements, repairing and replacing aging bridges, and increasing access and mobility options for the traveling public that would not have otherwise been possible without SB 1;

WHEREAS, the City utilizes community meetings, social media and publications to ensure public input into the community's transportation priorities;

WHEREAS, the City used a Pavement Management System to develop the SB1 project to ensure revenues are being used on the most high-priority and cost effective projects that also meet the community's priorities for transportation investment;

WHEREAS, the funding from SB1 will help the City maintain and rehabilitate several street segments of main collectors and arterials throughout the City this upcoming fiscal year;

WHEREAS, the 2018 California Statewide Local Streets and Roads Needs Assessment found that the City streets and roads are in average condition and this revenue will help us increase the overall quality of our road system and over the next decade will bring our street and roads into a good condition; and

WHEREAS, the SB1 project list and overall investment in our local streets and roads infrastructure with a focus on basic maintenance and safety, investing in complete streets infrastructure, and using cutting-edge technology, materials and practices, will have significant positive benefits in our City and statewide.

## NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that:

- 1. The foregoing recitations are true and correct, and are included herein by reference as findings.
- 2. The following list of proposed projects will be funded in-part or solely with Fiscal Year 2019/20 Road Maintenance and Rehabilitation Account revenues:
  - 1. Dover Avenue, from 17<sup>th</sup> Street to 23<sup>rd</sup> Street
  - 2. Rheem Avenue, from San Pablo Ave to 36th Street
  - 3. Tyler Street, from Dover Avenue to Davis Park
  - 4. Bush Street, from Rumrill Blvd. to 17th Street

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Council adopts this list of projects for Fiscal Year 2019/20 to be funded in part or solely by SB1 Road Maintenance and Rehabilitation Account funds.
