MOWDR provided a professional Spanish/English bilingual Care Manager on-site at the San Pablo Senior Centers on the 3rd Wednesday of each month, between the hours of 10:00am-2:30pm, to provide care management for low-income older adults. This is the busiest time at the Center. The Care Manager also spent 16 additional hours per month on follow-up services. San Pablo Senior Center staff also referred clients who could not wait until the 3rd Wednesday of the month to MOWDR's Care Managers for phone consultations. Services are provided at no cost to seniors served. Please see attachments for list of services rendered, and a client success story.

Jose and Maria are a San Pablo couple in their late 60s, living on a fixed income, who came to meet with MOWDR's Care Manager at the San Pablo Senior Center because they were distressed with financial issues and unable to cover all their expenses. They were afraid they would not be able to keep their apartment because it was a struggle to pay their rent every month. Our Care Manager worked with Jose and Maria to track all their income and expenses for three months. We helped them to identify their spending habits, and helped them establish a budget. They were also able to qualify for assistance in paying their utility bills. With some tight budgeting, Jose and Maria were able to carry on with much less financial stress.
