RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN PABLO AUTHORIZING THE CITY THROUGH THE PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT TO APPLY FOR THE STATE COASTAL CONSERVANCY PROPOSITION ONE GRANT FOR RUMRILL BOULEVARD COMPLETE STREETS PROJECT AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE THE GRANT APPLICATION AND ANY NECESSARY AGREEMENTS RELATED TO THIS GRANT APPLICATION

WHEREAS, the Water Quality, Supply and Infrastructure Improvement Act (Proposition 1) was approved by the voters in November 2014;

WHEREAS, State Coastal Conservancy (SCC) has been authorized to provide up to \$20 million in Proposition 1 funding to projects that meet one of the four priority types: water sustainability improvements, anadromous fish habitat enhancement, wetland restoration and urban greening;

WHEREAS, the implementation of green infrastructure along Rumrill Boulevard will create urban greening that will improve water quality to San Pablo Creek and Wildcat Creek and assist the City of San Pablo to comply with the NPDES Regional Municipal Permit;

WHEREAS, the City of San Pablo is an eligible entity to apply for SCC Proposition 1 funds;

WHEREAS, the City intends to apply for SCC Proposition 1 grant funds for Fiscal Year 2020/21 to install green infrastructure along Rumrill Boulevard between Costa Avenue and San Pablo Avenue;

WHEREAS, if awarded the Proposition 1 funding, staff will return to City Council to accept and appropriate all grant and required matching funds.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the foregoing recitations are true and correct, and are included herein by reference as findings;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Council authorizes the City staff to apply for the Proposition 1 grant from the State Coastal Conservancy;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Council also authorizes the City Manager to enter into any agreements related to this grant application to comply with grant application requirements.
