RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN PABLO APPROVING AN APPLICATION FOR CONTRA COSTA COUNTY CENSUS 2020 OUTREACH AND ASSISTANCE GRANTS

WHEREAS, the United States Census is upcoming in 2020 and the resulting count of San Pablo residents will be used to determine federal funding and representation levels affecting the entire community;

WHEREAS, Contra Costa County is committed to achieving a full count and in particular to reaching hard-to-count populations and as a result is offering grants to cities and other groups for outreach, education and awareness; non-English language outreach, education, and awareness; and innovative strategies;

WHEREAS, Contra Costa County has issued a request for Census 2020 Outreach and Assistance grant applications, in amounts ranging from \$500 to \$20,000, which are due by September 30, 2019;

WHEREAS, Community and Economic Development staff recommend pursuing one or more grants to help enhance the City of San Pablo count as such efforts will be in the best interests of the community; and

WHEREAS, successful grant applicants will enter into an agreement with Contra Costa County to complete the scope of services proposed under the successful grant application(s).

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council hereby approves the filing of one or more applications for the Contra Costa County Census 2020 Outreach and Assistance. If the grant application(s) are successful, staff will return to Council to accept and appropriate any grant funds.
