RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN PABLO ORDERING THE ENGINEER TO PREPARE AND FILE REPORTS FOR THE LEVY OF ANNUAL ASSESSMENTS FOR FISCAL YEAR 2020/21 FOR SAN PABLO STREET LIGHTING AND LANDSCAPE ASSESSMENT DISTRICT NO. 1982-1, AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT FOR THESE SERVICES WITH LCC ENGINEERING & SURVEYING, INC. IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$18,691

WHEREAS, LCC Engineering & Surveying, Inc. (LCC) has submitted a proposal to perform engineering services to the City;

WHEREAS, these services are necessary to provide an Engineer's Report pursuant to the provisions of the landscaping and Lighting Act of 1972 for continuation of the San Pablo Street Lighting and Landscape Assessment District No. 1982-1 for Fiscal Year 2020/21; and

WHEREAS, LCC has served as Assessment District Engineer since the formation of the assessment district in 1982 and staff recommends waiving the competitive proposal process because of LCC's familiarity with this assessment district and the particular services required and their unique expertise;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of San Pablo hereby finds that the foregoing recitations are true and correct, and are included herein by reference as findings;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of San Pablo hereby directs the Assessment District Engineer to prepare and file an Engineer's Report for San Pablo Street lighting and Landscape Assessment District No. 1982-1 for Fiscal Year 2020/21 in accordance with Article 4 (commencing with Section 22565) of Chapter 1 of the Landscaping and lighting Act of 1972 and Proposition 218;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Manager is authorized to execute a contract for said work with the engineering company of LCC and that said work shall be performed for an amount not to exceed the sum of \$18,691 (eighteen thousand six hundred and ninety-one dollars), to be paid from existing budget resources in the FY 2019/20 Street Lighting and Landscaping Assessment District fund budget (236-3710-43600) without engaging in a competitive proposal process because of LCC's unique familiarity and expertise with the City's assessment district; and BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that proposed new improvements or substantial changes in existing improvements are generally described as streetlight improvements (additional illumination in various area); concept design and community input for 1701 Bush Avenue new pocket park; Wanlass Park playground replacement; hydration stations at Davis and Wanlass parks; and landscape improvements at Davis Park, Rumrill Sports Park, Wanlass Park and the San Pablo Community Center.
